## **BRAIDED NICU BLANKET**

## **Materials**

- 2 skeins of any yarn from the Knots of Love required yarn list.
- Size US 8 (5mm) knitting needles.
- Tapestry needle

Finished Size: 24" x 30"

## **Instructions:**

Cast on 150 (Multiple of 4 plus 2).

## Pattern:

First Edge: Knit 4 rows.

Row 1: K4, p2, \*[k2, p2], repeat from \* across until you reach the last 4 stitches. K4.

Row 2: K4, k2, \*[p2, k2], repeat from \* across until you reach the last 4 stitches. K4.

Row 3: K4, p2, \*[k2tog and without dropping the stitches off your left-hand needle, knit the

first stitch. Drop both stitches. p2]. Repeat from \* across until you reach the last 4 stitches. K4.

Row 4: K4, k2, \*[p2, k2]; repeat from \* across until you reach the last 4 stitches. K4.

Repeat Rows 1 - 4 until the desired blanket reaches at least 30" in length.

End with row 3.

Second Edge: Knit 4 rows.

**<u>Finishing:</u>** Bind off and weave in ends.


