# OCCASIONAL PURL PATTERN **SLOUCHY STYLE**



## Materials:

Needles: Size 7 (16" inch) Circular needles,

Size 8 (16" inch) Circular Needles,

double point needles

Yarn: Any yarn from the Knots of Love required yarn list

#### Instructions:

Cast on 72 or 80 stitches

**BRIM:** Using size 7 needles

Preferred:

**Row 1:** \* K1, p1; rep from \* to end of row. Row 2: \* P1, k1; rep from \* to end of row. Rep Rows 1 and 2 for pattern for 1 to 1.5"

(Shown: Knit 1 row, Purl 1 row to the desired width)



### Change to size 8 needles

Rnd 1: (Increase round) Increase 20 knit stitches evenly around. You will now have 100 stitches.

Rnd 2: Knit around

Rnd 3: Knit around **Rnd 8:** K2, P1, \*K3, P1 repeat from \* around.

Rnd 9: Knit around Rnd 4: P1, K3 around Rnd 10: Knit around Rnd 5: Knit around Rnd 11: Knit around Rnd 6: Knit around

Repeat rounds 4 -11 until cap reaches 7 inches from brim Rnd 7: Knit around

#### **CROWN SHAPING:**

When circular needles become too long for the decreasing amount of stitches, begin knitting off onto double point needles, 2 sections per needle. Or if you know how to work in the round with 2 circulars, divide the knitting in half while knitting around.

Rnd 1: Knit 8, knit 2 together. Rnd 11: Knit 3, K2 together. Rnd 2: And each even number round knit plain around. Rnd 13: Knit 2, K2 together. NOTE: In each even row, purl a stitch Rnd 15: Knit 1, K2 together. occasionally to continue the look. Rnd 16: K2 together

Rnd 3: Knit 7, knit 2 together.

Rnd 5: Knit 6, knit 2 together.

Rnd 7: Knit 5, knit 2 together.

Rnd 9: Knit 4, knit 2 together.

Only 2 stitches remain in each section. Break yarn, leaving 12". Cut yarn, thread finishing needle, and draw thru remaining stitches, securing on the wrong side.


