ARMY RANGER BEANIE



Materials:

Needles:

Size 16" (#8) circular needles Size 8 double point needles

Yarn: 200-225 yards of any yarn from the Knots of Love's <u>approved list of yarns</u>.

Tapestry needle
11 Stitch markers





Instructions:

Using 16" (#8) circular needles

Cast on 80 sts.

Place a stitch marker at the beginning of your round being careful not to twist the stitches.

Brim: K1, P1 for 3 inches

Body:

Rnds 1-2: K1, P1. Repeat around.

Rnds 3-4: P1, K1. Repeat around.

Continue working rounds 1-4 until your work measures 9" from cast on edge.

Crown: Change to double point needles or two circular needles when needed.

Rnd 1: *K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, P2tog. Repeat from * to end of round. (Place a stitch marker after each section.)

Rnd 2: *K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1. Repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 3: *P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, P2tog. Repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 4: *P1, K1, P1, K1, P1. Repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 5: *K1, P1, K1, P1, P2tog. Repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 6: *K1, P1, K1, P1. Repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 7: *P1, K1, P1, P2tog. Repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 8: *P1, K1, P1, P1. Repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 9: *K1, P1, P2tog. Repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 10: *K1, P2tog

Finishing: Only 2 stitches remain in each section. Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through remaining stitches and remove stitches from the needles. Pull to gather and close the top opening. Weave in the remaining tail.

Another variation of this beanie is to make it without a wide brim.

Yarn used in this example is: Berroco Comfort color 9839



Instructions:

Using 16" (#8) circular needles

Cast on 80 sts.

Place a stitch marker at the beginning of your round being careful not to twist the stitches.

Brim:

Rnds 1-7: K1, P1. Repeat around.

Body:

Rnds 1-2: K1, P1. Repeat around.

Rnds 3-4: P1, K1. Repeat around.

Continue working rounds 1-4 until your work measures 6.5" from cast on edge.

Crown: Change to double point needles or two circular needles when needed.

Rnd 1: *K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, P2tog. Repeat from * to end of round. (Place a stitch marker after each section.)

Rnd 2: *K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1. Repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 3: *P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, P2tog. Repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 4: *P1, K1, P1, K1, P1. Repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 5: *K1, P1, K1, P1, P2tog. Repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 6: *K1, P1, K1, P1, P1. Repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 7: *P1, K1, P1, P2tog. Repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 8: *P1, K1, P1, P1. Repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 9: *K1, P1, P2tog. Repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 10: *K1, P2toq

Finishing: Only 2 stitches remain in each section. Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through remaining stitches and remove stitches from the needles. Pull to gather and close the top opening. Weave in the remaining tail.

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









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
