VETERAN'S HERO LIMB HUGGER

Materials:

Needles: Size 7, 12" circular needles

Size 7 Double point needles

Yarn: 200-225 yards of any yarn from the Knots of Love's

approved list of yarns.

Tapestry needle Stitch marker

Instructions:

Cast on 56 stitches. Be careful not to twist. Place stitch marker and begin working in the round.

Ribbing:

Row 1: *(K1, P1); repeat around. Repeat this row for 3 inches.

Body:

Row 1: *(K2, P2), repeat from * around. **Row 2:** *(P2, K2), repeat from * around. Repeat these two rows for 6 inches.

Decrease: (Change to double-point needles when necessary)

Row 1: *(K5, K2 together), repeat from * around **Row 4:** *(K2, K2 together), repeat from * around **Row 5:** *(K1, K2 together), repeat from * around

Row 3: *(K3, K2 together), repeat from * around

Finishing: 8 stitches remain. Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through remaining stitches and remove stitches from needle. Pull to gather and close top opening. Weave in remaining tail.



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
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
