BREEZY SUMMERSPUN BEACH HAT

Materials:

Needles: US 4 & US 6 16" Circular Needles;

US 6 Double Point Needles

Yarn: 200-225 yards Premier Cotton Sprout.

Stitch Marker

Size: Will fit a 19-21" head

Gauge: 16sx18r on size US 6/4mm knitting needles.

Abbreviations:

• k2tog - Decrease - knit two stitches together at the same time

• **ssk** - Decrease - slip first stitch as if to knit, slip second stitch as if to knit, insert left needle into front of both stitches and knit together.

• kfb - Increase by knitting into the front and back of a stitch.

• St st - Stockinette stitch



Instructions:

With US 4 needle cast on 104 sts. Join in the round with crossover join, placing marker to indicate beginning of round. **Knit 6 rounds.**

Ribbing: *K2, P2; rpt from * for 6 rounds.

Body: Next round: change to larger needles (US 6) and increase (kfb) 22 sts evenly around – you now have 126 sts. Continue working in St st for 5 1/2" from bottom of rolled edge.

Decreasing/Shape Crown: (Change to dpn's when necessary)

Round 1: *k1, ssk, k9, k2tog; rpt from * around (108 sts)

Round 2 & 3: Knit

Round 4: *k1, ssk, k7, k2tog; rpt from * around (90 sts)

Round 5 & 6: Knit

Round 7: *k1, ssk, k5, k2tog; rpt from * around (72 sts)

Round 8 & 9: Knit

Round 10: *k1, ssk, k3, k2tog; rpt from * around (54 sts)

Round 11 & 12: Knit

Round 13: *k1, ssk, k1, k2tog; rpt from * around (36 sts)

Round 14 & 15: Knit

Round 16: *k1, slip 2 sts tog as if to knit, k1, pass 2 slipped stitches over k1; rpt from * around (18 sts)

Cut yarn leaving a 10" tail for sewing. Thread darning needle with end and weave through remaining stitches; pull tightly & secure end.





