BIG BOW SLOUCH



Materials:

Needles: Size 8 (16") circular needles Size 8 Double Point Needles

Yarn: 200-225 yards of any yarn from the Knots of Love's approved list of yarns. 2 colors of yarn - main and

small amount of contrasting color

Tapestry needle

Abbreviations:

- kfb = knit in front and in back of same stitch
- K2tog = knit 2 stitches together

Instructions:

Pattern:

- Cast on 80 stitches in the main color. Being careful not to twist. Begin to K1, P1 every row for 1 inch. (The remainder of the cap is knit only.)
- Increase to 88 stitches: *K9, kfb; repeat from * around
- K 5 rows in main color
- Switch to contrasting color and K for 6 rows.
- Return to main color and continue knitting until cap measures 7 inches from cast on edge.

Decreasing: switch to double point needles when needed.

Rnd 1: *K9, K2tog; repeat from * around

Rnds 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12: K around

Rnd 3: *K8, K2tog; repeat from * aroundRnd 5: *K7, K2tog; repeat from * around

Rnd 7: *K6, K2tog; repeat from * around

Rnd 9: *K5, K2tog; repeat from * around

Rnd 11: *K4, K2tog; repeat from * around

Rnd 13: *K3, K2tog; repeat from * around Rnd 14: *K2, K2tog; repeat from * around

Rnd 15: *K1, K2tog; repeat from * around

Rnd 16: K2tog around

(Rnd 17: K2tog) if desired to make less

stitches to close cap

Finishing:

Cut yarn, leaving 12" tail. Place yarn on a tapestry needle and thread stitches from dpns to cinch closed. Knot and weave in ends.

Directions for the bow:

Cast 12-14 stitches (depending on desired bow size) onto straight needles Knit every row until the piece measures 7"
Bind off.

Cut long piece of yarn. Double it and wrap around middle of the bow to create the center. Attach securely to cap.


