

## CHRIS T'S SLIP STITCH CAP



### **Materials:**

Needles: 16" Size 8 circular needle  
Size 8 double-point needles (See [NOTE](#) below)  
Yarn: 200-250 yards of any yarn from the Knots of Love's [approved list of yarns](#). (2 colors)  
Yarn sewing needle

***This will make a women's size medium cap.***

***Main color:*** Color A      ***Contrast color:*** Color B

### **Instructions:**

With Color A, cast on 88 stitches. Place marker and join, being careful not to twist the stitches.

Knit 8 rows with Color A for a rolled brim.

Begin two-color stitch pattern:

#### **Rows:**

- 1 & 2** Knit with Color A.
- 3 & 4** With Color B, knit 2, \*slip 2 with yarn in back, knit 2. Repeat from \* around, ending with slip 2.
- 5 & 6** Knit with Color A.
- 7 & 8** With Color B, knit 2, \*slip 2 with yarn in back, knit 2. Repeat from \* around, ending with slip 2.
- 9 & 10** Knit with Color B.
- 11 & 12** With Color A, knit 2, \*slip 2 with yarn in back, knit 2. Repeat from \* around, ending with slip 2.
- 13 & 14** Knit with Color B.
- 15 & 16** With Color A, knit 2, \*slip 2 with yarn in back, knit 2. Repeat from \* around, ending with slip 2.

Repeat this pattern twice more. (You have knit it 3 times total.)  
Cap should now measure 7" from the cast-on row.

Knit one plain row with Color A.

Decreasing for the crown, knitting with Color A: (Change to double-point needles when necessary.)

**NOTE:** Because I don't like to knit with double-points, I use a second 16" circular needle and transfer half of the remaining stitches to it when the row becomes too short to knit with just one circular.

#### **Row:**

- |   |   |
|---|---|
| <b>1</b> Knit 9, knit 2 together, repeat to end of row. | <b>9</b> Knit 5, knit 2 tog. Repeat.                                |
| <b>2</b> Knit this row and all even-numbered rows.      | <b>11</b> Knit 4, knit 2 tog. Repeat.                               |
| <b>3</b> Knit 8, knit 2 tog. Repeat.                    | <b>13</b> Knit 3, knit 2 tog. Repeat.                               |
| <b>5</b> Knit 7, knit 2 tog. Repeat.                    | <b>15</b> Knit 2, knit 2 tog. Repeat.                               |
| <b>7</b> Knit 6, knit 2 tog. Repeat.                    | <b>17</b> Knit 1, knit 2 tog. Repeat.                               |
|   | <b>19</b> Knit 2 tog. Repeat. You should have 8 stitches remaining. |

#### **Close top:**

Cut yarn, leaving a 12" tail. Using a yarn needle, weave the yarn tail through each of the 8 remaining stitches. Remove stitches from needles. Pull tight. Thread to inside of cap. Weave in all yarn ends.



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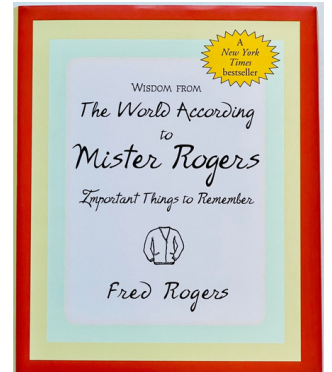
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
