# MADELINE PATTERN BAND **VARIATIONS**



To create an area of interest on a cap, WITHOUT ADDING A NEW COLOR, try one of these variations. Simply begin the cap by casting 80 stitches onto #7 (16") circular needle and knit "in the round" until piece measures 1.5-2.5 inches (depending on how much you want the brim to roll). When cap reaches desired length, begin with one of the following. The new pattern should measure approx. 1-1.5" but may be any width you desire to create the illusion of a hat band.

#### **BAKER STREET**

Pattern:

Rnd 1: Purl Rnd 2: K1, P1

Repeat these 2 rows until desired width is achieved, then Purl 1 row. Continue knitting around and complete the cap following the Madeline instructions.



#### SPIRAL\*

\*Requires 79 stitches. So, knit 2tog to create a decrease before beginning the pattern.

Pattern: Rnd 1: P

Rnd 2: K6, P4 around.

Continue pattern around until the desired width is achieved, then PURL one round. Complete cap using Madeline instructions.



#### **CHECKS**

Pattern:

Rnds 1-4: K4, P4 Rnds 5-8: P4, K4

Resume knitting and complete cap following Madeline instructions.



## **TINY CHECKS**

Pattern:

Rnd 1-2: K2, P2 Rnd 3-4: P2, K2

Repeat these rows until desired width is achieved. Complete cap using Madeline pattern.



## **CABLE LOOK** (psso = pass slip stitch over)

Pattern sequence is 4 rows.

Rnd 1: \*sl st, K2, psso, P2; repeat from \* around Rnd 2: \*K1, YO, K1, P2; repeat from \* around

Rnd 3: \*K3, P2; repeat from \* around

Rnd 4: repeat Rnd 3

Repeat sequence as desired (2 sequences should be adequate), then repeat rounds 1 and 2. Complete cap following Madeline pattern.



## **CRISS CROSS STITCH**

Pattern:

Rnd 1: \*sl st as if to purl, K1, YO, psso, K2; repeat from \* around

Rnd 2: K around Repeat these 2 rows 4 times.

Complete cap using Madeline pattern.
