GLOBAL AMBASSADOR

Eligibility

- Be between 16 and 18 years of age
- Be available to participate in the programme from October 2022
- Contributes to the broad diversity of the Global Ambassadors team by bringing unique knowledge, interests and/or expertise to the group
- Applicants may include international students, residents and citizens of Aotearoa New Zealand who live within Tauranga or Western Bay of Plenty

Who would make a good ambassador?

- Likes to be challenged and work outside their comfort zone
- Interested in working with a diverse and dynamic team
- Able to demonstrate an interest in supporting and contributing to their local community.

What you give

- Monthly investment of at least 12 hours (includes in-person and online)
- 2 days per quarter during school term breaks for in-person meetings and workshops
- Occasionally attend events, festivals or meetings as a Global Ambassador delegate.
- Support and/or lead project that are taken on by the Global Ambassadors.

What you receive

- Training and skills development
- Valuable certifications, and recognition of service as part of the programme.
- Increased self-awareness and confidence
- Develop your professional network and portfolios

VOLUNTEER PROJECT ASSISTANT

Volunteer Project Assistants are individuals between the ages of 19 and 25 years who support the Project Lead. This role is predomantly online with optional opportunities to engage in-person, with a comittment of at least 8 hours per month. Project Assistants must be trustworthy role models for the Global Ambassadors, and exemplify the ideals of the project.
