Veneers can literally change a patient's smile. For some patients, however, the expense and time commitment required for conventional veneers can put this life-altering cosmetic improvement out of reach. That's why Silmet developed ProVeneer, which is described as a resin-based foundation material that allows dentists to create a veneer in 15 minutes or less in one visit to achieve natural-looking results at an affordable price.

Dr. Michael LaMarche was among a team of dentists who recently evaluated ProVeneer for Dental Product Shopper, reporting on everything from handling and working time to patient satisfaction.
"[ProVeneer] provides an iimmediate solution for the esthetic-minded patientt aitaccost that's more affordable than ceramic veneers or crowns," LaMarche shared. "The relatively low cost of material, easy handling characteristics, and great esthetics provide a great cost-effective alternative for patients."

## Handling, Working Time and Consistency

According to Silmet, ProVeneer is the only material developed specifically for creating lab-free custom veneers. It has a bubble-free consistency and does not require layering or in-office laboratory processing. With a unique Bis-GMA-TEGDMA-UDMA balance that keeps the material from sticking to gloves and instruments, ProVeneer can be cemented in less than 15 minutes per tooth. The system includes all tools and materials necessary for quick, natural-looking veneers in one dental visit.

Dr. Lucynda Raben said it was great to find "a veneer solution without the lab time" and added that ProVeneer's ease of use made for a very successful appointment. "The working time is more than adequate for the slowest of practitioners-without the fear of setting up while sculpting the material," said Dr.


LaMarche. With other veneer systems, Dr. Sherwood Tucker found that adding composite veneers piecemeal would sometimes lead to bubbles. With ProVeneer, the composite is added in one piece so there is less chance of bubbles developing, Dr. Tucker said.

The ProVeneer technique can be learned in a simple training webinar on Silmet's website. Dr. Karen-Lee Jones Stewart said the video training was excellent and she was well-prepared for her first case. Dr. Tucker said a younger colleague, who hadn't done many veneers, "was able to learn the technique quickly and completely, [and] the finished product was superb."

## Esthetics: Finishing and Polishing

"We loved being able to go from start to finish with a product that's so easy to work with and looks so natural," said Dr. Raben, whose favorite feature was "the ability to have a very thin covering with tremendous results." Dr. Cynthia Leung, who said she would like to see more shades in the future, noted, "I love that the material polishes up to a great finish."

According to Silmet, ProVeneer maintains translucency to provide a natural appearance while masking out many tooth discolorations. After receiv-
