# Four Truths

## 1. God, Our Creator, Loves Us!

"For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life." John 3:16, ESV

#### God's Love

In John 3:16, **love** is translated from the Greek word "Agape."

- ♥ It is *selfless*, *sacrificial* love.
- ◆ Agape love is unique from other types of love, which are often *self-centered*.

#### SPIRITUAL DEATH

The penalty for Sin is Death.

- This death is more than just our bodies dying. It is spiritual separation from God.
- At our physical death, this separation becomes **eternal**.

**The separation** between God and Sinful Man is huge.

- We are unable to bridge it, no matter how "good" we are.
- It is as impossible as swimming from Hawaii to Los Angeles. Even the best swimmer is unable to swim 2000 miles over open ocean!

- O trusting in all He has done on the Cross to purchase your forgiveness.

# **Receiving Christ**

# Assurance of Eternal Life

"Most assuredly, I [Jesus] say to you, he who believes in Me has everlasting life." John 6:47, NKJV

1 John 5:11-13, ESV

#### **ETERNAL LIFE**

- O is not based on how "good" we are or how we feel.
- O is only based on our faith in Jesus Christ.
