### Calling all Honda CB750 SOHC owners!

#### **The Honda CB750 – 50th Anniversary Celebration Open Day.**

The first Honda CB750 was launched at the Tokyo Motor Show in October 1968, this year celebrates its 50th Anniversary.

**To celebrate, a special CB750 SOHC Open Day will be held at The David Silver Honda Collection museum in Leiston, Suffolk on Saturday 29th September 2018.**

The event is open to all owners of any of the 1969 to 1978 SOHC CB750 models. Specifically:

- CB750 (1969)
- CB750-K0/K1/K2/K3/K4/K5/K6/K7 & K8 (1970 to 1978)
- CB750A Hondamatic (all models)
- CB750-F1/F2/F3
- CB750 Phil Read Replica & CB750SS Honda Britain (CB750-F2)
- Your CB750 SOHC Special (Custom, Racer or similar)

To commemorate the special occasion, David Silver's aim is to attract as many SOHC CB750's as possible to the one special day, to celebrate the CB750's 50th Birthday.

The David Silver Honda Collection museum will be open with free entry on the day and refreshments will be available.
