Wartime experience:

Edward was enlisted into the Royal Artillery and posted to 137th Field Regiment (Blackpool) on 19 October 1939. On 4 February 1941 was appointed as 'Driver in Charge'.

He was posted to overseas to Malaya on 28 September 1941 and was posted as missing on 7 January 1942, when he was captured by the Japanese and sent to the Malai camp. He worked on the Thai/Burma railway and sadly passed away, suffering from Cholera on 30 May 1943.

He is buried in Thanbyuzayat War Cemetery in Burma. Plot B4, Row O, Grave 9.
