Cremation

Cremation is chosen by many families and individuals as an alternative to traditional burial. The reasons for selecting cremation may be based on personal or religious beliefs. It is important to remember that cremation is simply one part of the final memorialization process.

Whether choosing cremation or another means of preparing the body for final disposition, there is still need for a meaningful gathering to commemorate or celebrate the special life of a loved one and to assist survivors in the grieving and healing process. This tribute can take place before or after cremation and may be as personalized as you choose.

Paying Tribute

Memorial and remembrance services have evolved in recent years to include a much greater variety of options for honoring and celebrating lives of friends and loved ones. Today, cremation services are becoming more popular with the blending of traditional funeral services with cremation. The trained and caring staff of Harry McKneely and Son Funeral Home can help you choose the types of services that reflect the personality of your family, friends and loved ones.

Visitation

The visitation is a gathering that precedes the memorial or funeral service where the remains are present in a casket, and members of the immediate family greet those who come to offer condolences. The cremation simply takes place later.

The custom of seeing the loved one a final time often helps the bereaved accept that a death has occurred, allowing them to resolve grief more readily.

Funeral Service

Though you may not associate cremation with a funeral service, it is possible to have both. A funeral service simply refers to an observance of someone's passing where the remains are present, usually in a casket (though another possibility is to have the ashes present in an urn).

The funeral service provides an opportunity for friends and family to gather in mutual support and sorrow to observe the passing of one who has been important in their lives. This observance may be held in a church, funeral home or other venue, such as a natural setting. Depending on religious or cultural customs, the service may sometimes continue at the cemetery.

Memorial Service

A memorial service describes a gathering to honor someone's passing where the remains are not present. An important purpose of the memorial service is to support and give comfort to the immediate family and close friends. The memorial service may be held in a funeral home chapel, a place of worship, or a natural setting that held meaning for your loved one. It may take place within a few days of the passing, or it may occur weeks or even months later, to allow friends and family members time to gather.

Scattering Service

Scattering Services accompany the physical release of ashes at the place of disposition, such as a national park, the ocean, or a scattering garden at a local cemetery, if available. The scattering service may be a continuation of services begun at a funeral home chapel or place of worship.

Please note: All states allow for the scattering of ashes, but scattering on private property is restricted without the consent of the property owner. Many national and state parks require permits for scattering, and although the U.S. government allows ocean scattering, it can be no closer than three miles from land. You should consult your local authorities regarding the requirements for scattering in your state.

Inurnment Service

An inurnment service refers to a ceremony accompanying the placement of ashes in a cemetery. Inurnment services may be held at the site where the ashes are to be placed, such as a niche wall, columbarium or cremation garden, or in another designated site within the cemetery.

Such services may include religious or cultural elements, and they may be a continuation of services begun at a funeral home chapel or place of worship. Like a funeral or memorial service, an inurnment service is a caring and meaningful event during which family and friends have the opportunity to pay a final tribute to their loved one.
