- 3. Donate bus passes, stamps, and stationery
- Collect winter supplies: hats, gloves, scarves, and hand warmers
- 5. Educate others about homelessness
- **6.** Donate a backpack or tote
- 7. Provide gift cards for fast food or grocery stores
- 8. Tell a neighbor "hello"
- Donate new art supplies: paint, paint brushes, markers, and colored pencils
- Educate yourself about agencies that serve our community
- 11. Host a fundraising event spotlighting Room In The Inn: online silent auction, live-streamed musical performance, drive-thru coffee stand, virtual fun run
- 12. Donate office supplies
- **13.** Be informed about legislation that affects those experiencing homelessness
- 14. Host a community cleanup in your area
- **15.** Provide opportunities for others to learn about how they can get involved
- 16. Contribute to the Room In The Inn Community Prayer Wall
- **17.** Get your family, business, or congregation involved to sponsor or donate a meal
- 18. Donate new, adult underwear: sizes M, L, XL
- 19. Donate janitorial supplies

- **20.** Donate new items for Welcome Home Baskets: new bath towels, kitchen towels, set of 4 dishes and silverware, and cooking utensils

Welcome Home Basket – 12 Days of Christmas

Did you know that the 12 days of Christmas starts on December 25 and goes through January 6? Celebrate the 12 Days of Christmas by making a Welcome Home Basket for someone who is moving from the streets to a new home.

This year, instead of singing a really long holiday song, spend each of the 12 days purchasing and gathering items for a Welcome Home Basket. Bring the basket to Room In The Inn and they will provide it to one of our new neighbors.

Welcome Home Basket - 12 Days of Christmas

December 25 – 35-Gallon latch storage tote to store all of the items

December 26 – Shower curtain liner and hooks

December 27 – Wash clothes, bath towels, and a bathmat

December 28 – Small trash can with trash bags

December 29 – Silverware, spatula, and serving spoon

December 30 – Cookware: pots, pans, skillets, etc.

December 31 – Dishes and drinking glasses

January 1 – Kitchen cleaner and dish soap

January 2 – Plastic cutting board and colander

January 3 - Dish towels and sponges

January 4 - Full size sheet set and pillow

January 5 – Toilet paper and paper towels

January 6 – Bring the filled Welcome Home Basket to Room In The Inn, 705 Drexel Street, Nashville, TN 37203
