Boothbay Region Student Aid Fund



Providing Grants – Not Loans –
for up to Six Years of Post-Secondary
Education or Training

WHO WE ARE:

- A 501(c)3 non-profit organization
- An all-volunteer board providing grants (not loans) to Boothbay Region High School graduates
- **Operating expenses average 5%**



WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW:

- Grants are based on an applicant's unmet need
- **Qualified applicants may receive grants for up to six academic years, which can include three years at the graduate level**
 - Minimum grants are \$500 with no maximum
- **BRHS graduates returning later in life are eligible**

WHAT WE HAVE DONE SINCE OUR BEGINNING:

- 1964: 10 grants given totaling \$3,500
- 2021-2022: 66 grants given totaling \$435,350
- Average grant for 2021-2022: \$6,596
- **In the past five years 381 grants have been given totaling over \$2,011,000**



WHERE SUPPORT FOR GRANTS COMES FROM:

- **Donations to the Annual Fund**
 - Invested Funds (average withdrawal rate of 4%-5%)



WHO WE SUPPORT:

- Students continuing their post-secondary education
- Students with unmet need
 - Students enrolled in a certificate or vocation program
- **Students enrolled in an accredited program at any community college, technical or trade school, college, or graduate school**
