Emuna Elon was born in Jerusalem (1955) to a family of rabbis and scholars and was raised in Jerusalem and New York. She teaches Judaism, Hassidism and Hebrew literature, and has served as Advisor to the Prime Minister on the status of Israeli women (1996-1997). She wrote a weekly political column in the mass circulation daily *Yedioth Ahronoth*, and later in *Israel Hayom*. Elon has published essays, short stories, popular children's books and four bestselling novels. Her novel *If You Awaken Love* was a finalist for the National Jewish Book Award (2007). Elon received the Book Publishers Association's Gold Book Prize (2010), the Prime Minister's Prize for Writers (2015) and the Minister of Education Prize for Literature (2018).
