He served as Israel Ambassador to the United States and former Chief Negotiator with Syria in the mid 1990's and as the president of Tel-Aviv University (1999-2007). He has been a member of Tel Aviv University's faculty since 1971. His most recent book is Yitzhak Rabin: Soldier, Leader, Statesman (Yale University Press, 2017). He is currently completing a book titled Syrian Requiem dealing with the Syrian civil war to be published by Princeton University Press in 2020.
