New recycling schedule begins Fall 2019

Place at the Curb

GARBAGE must be placed in a grey or black covered bins, or durable, black plastic bags.

COMINGLED RECYCLING (aluminum, glass, plastics numbered 1, 2, 5) must be clean, dry and placed in blue covered bins, available for free at the Hoboken Recycling Center. Plastic bags are NOT recyclable.

PAPER RECYCLING (paper, cardboard) must be dry, flattened and bundled in cardboard boxes or tied with string. Please don't put paper recycling out in the rain! Styrofoam is NOT recyclable.
