



Residential Composting



You drop it off *or* We pick it up

1 Sign up!

Register for FREE compost drop off by taking the “what can you compost” quiz at www.hobokennj.gov/compost.

2 Collect

Collect food scraps and paper products in any airtight container or paper bag. *Pro Tip:* store it in the freezer!

3 Drop off

The City will email you a combination to open the green compost bin. Drop off your food scraps at one of the FREE drop off sites:

- City Hall 94 Washington St
- Church Square Park 400 Garden St
- Elysian Park 1100 Hudson St
- 7th & Jackson Plaza 600 Seventh St

Please only drop food scraps in the green bin!

Composting diverts waste from the landfill, reduces greenhouse gas emissions, and saves taxpayers money.

1 Sign up!

Register for weekly (\$39/mo) or bi-weekly (\$24/mo) pickup from Community Compost Company at www.communitycompostco.com/

2 Schedule Pickup

Community Compost Company emails you to schedule your weekly or bi-weekly pickup day/location, and drops off an empty bucket.

3 Full Bucket

Place your bucket filled with food scraps at your doorstep on your pickup day.

4 Empty Bucket

Community Compost Company picks up your full bucket and drops off a clean, empty bucket.

5 Get soil!

Twice per year, Community Compost Company drops off finished compost (soil) with your clean, empty bucket.
