

**CITY OF HOBOKEN  
NOTICE OF THIRD SUBSTANTIAL  
AMENDMENT TO FY 2020 ANNUAL  
ACTION PLAN**

The purpose of this notice is to present a substantial amendment to the City of Hoboken's FY2020 Annual Action Plan to amend the use funds. In accordance with Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program regulations, the City is allowed to make substantial amendments to its Annual Action Plan and Budget in accordance with the City's Citizen Participation Plan.

The City of Hoboken is amending the approved FY2020 CDBG Annual Action Plan to reprogram funds awarded to HOPES Community Action Partnership to support the overall administration of the CDBG program. This is considered a substantial amendment in accordance with Hoboken's Citizen Participation Plan.

This document will be available to the public for a period of thirty (30) days -- until July 6, 2021, after which time the Substantial Amendment will be considered by Hoboken City Council for approval and submission to HUD.

All interested persons, groups, and organizations are encouraged to attend this virtual public hearing and will be given the opportunity to present oral or written testimony concerning the proposed amendment for the FY 2020 Annual Action Plan.
