

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND COMMENT PERIOD
CITY OF HOBOKEN
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT
2021 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN**

The City of Hoboken has prepared a draft 2021 Annual Action Plan as part of its application for funding to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The City's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) for FY 2021 is \$1,088,621. The City is also using this opportunity to reprogram \$104,493 in unspent funding from its 2020 Annual Action Plan. CDBG funds may be used to assist persons with low to moderate incomes, remove slums and blight, or address urgent needs.

To solicit feedback from the residents, the City will hold an online virtual public hearing on Monday, June 28, 2021 at 2PM. The purpose of this meeting is to obtain views of citizens, public agencies and other interested parties on the draft Annual Action Plan.

Citizens are invited to provide written or verbal comments over the next thirty days. Mr. Leckington should also be contacted by any person wishing to attend the public hearing and requiring an auxiliary aid, service or other accommodation to participate in the hearing.

Comments must be received by July 20, 2021 in order to be reviewed prior to the July 21, 2021 City Council meeting where the Hoboken City Council will consider a resolution to adopt the Annual Action Plan and authorize its submission to HUD.
