CITY OF HOBOKEN NOTICE OF SECOND SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO FY 2021 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN

This notice presents a substantial amendment to the City of Hoboken's FY 2021 Annual Action Plan for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds. In July 2021, the City submitted an Annual Action Plan to program its allocation of CDBG funding. CDBG program regulations permit the City to make substantial amendments to the Annual Action Plan and Budget in accordance with the City's Citizen Participation Plan. Hoboken is amending the approved FY 2021 CDBG Annual Action Plan to eliminate one project and increase the budget of an existing project. The amendment to the FY 2021 CDBG Annual Action Plan is summarized as follows:
