

HELP ELIMINATE RODE NITS

The City of Hoboken continues to partner with exterminators to mitigate recent rodent activity.

But we need your help!

- All businesses must secure garbage in a container with a tight-fitting lid, and place it curbside in a garbage can as close to collection time as possible.
- Businesses must have enough garbage containers to sufficiently store garbage between collections, and each container must have a tight-fitting lid.
- Businesses should line garbage containers with heavy duty plastic bags. Place a rag soaked with a 10% bleach solution at the bottom and top of each bag before tying the bag tightly to reduce leakage.
- Businesses must thoroughly clean all outdoor dining areas and wash streateries with soap, water, and bleach everyday Rats only need an ounce of food to survive, so quickly clean up and discard any spilled food.
- Businesses should power wash beneath your parklet structure daily to discourage harborage.
- Businesses should remove any standing water.
- Businesses should work closely with their exterminator to amend treatments as necessary.
