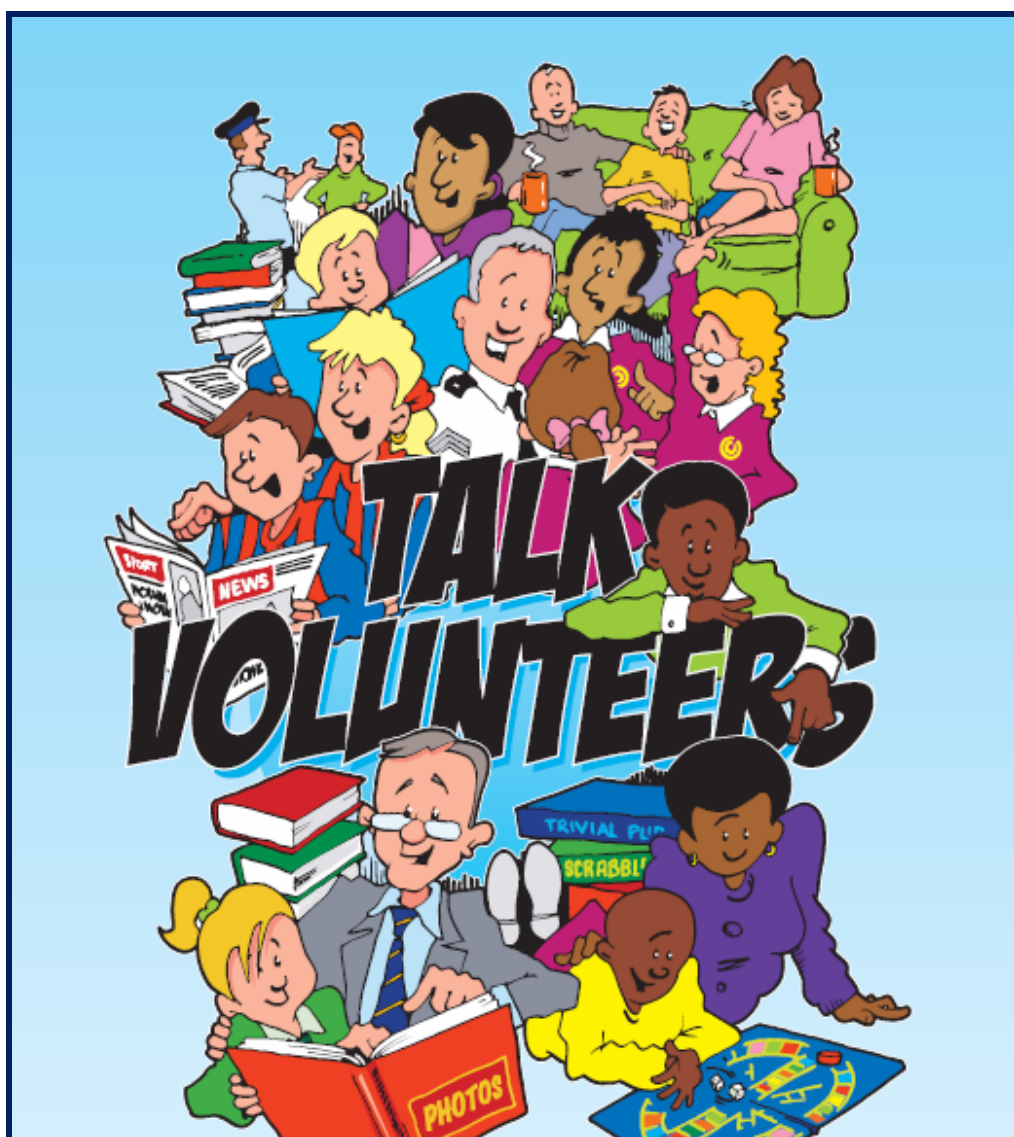

What is the Talk Volunteer programme?

The Talk Volunteer programme is an individual intervention programme which aims to:

- Give pupils an opportunity to develop and practise speaking and listening skills
- Help them feel positive about talking
- Develop skills in being able to structure their talk

Which pupils would benefit?

Pupils who would benefit from the Talk Volunteers programme are those who:

- Need a boost to their speaking and listening skills and who seem likely to respond well to this kind of support
- Are less likely to volunteer oral contributions in the larger class group
- Use talk that is generally limited e.g. they give single word or short phrase responses
- Have writing levels that reflect poor oral language skills

What's in the package?

The Talk Volunteer Resource Pack contains comprehensive resources to enable you to run an effective and enjoyable intervention.

It includes:

- Individual session plans (10 to 15 minutes long) to run a 6 or 12 week intervention programme
- Frameworks to support speaking and listening
- Organisational resources
- Recording and assessment proformas

The Talkit Toolkit contains a range of additional resources to run the programme (pictures, grids, diagrams, maps etc.).
