

MYRTLE MARINO ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP FUND

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Myrtle Marino Endowed Scholarship Fund was established in 2010 with a donation of funds from the estate of Myrtle Nall Marino who passed away in September 2009. An Endowed Fund, administered by First Baptist Church, Denton, Texas, is the basis for the funding and income from the Fund is to be donated to worthy students from the church who have been accepted for admission at, or are already attending, Baylor University in Waco, or another Baylor University campus.

The scholarship funding will be available beginning with Fall Semester 2010. If the amount of funding is \$500 or greater, the check will be sent directly to the financial office of the Baylor University campus where the student is enrolled.

The Scholarship Committee of First Baptist Church, Denton, Texas, developed the Guidelines for Awarding of the Scholarship and will make the final decision on recipient(s).

For school year 2024-2025, applications must be submitted on or before April 30, 2024, for evaluation by the Scholarship Committee. The form is available online at www.firstdenton.org/scholarship or a print copy may be secured from the Pastor's Office, First Baptist Church, 1100 Malone Street, Denton, TX 76201-2799.

The application may be completed online. Additional materials to be submitted with the application may be scanned and sent to pattyc@firstdenton.org, or may be mailed or delivered to the Pastor's Office at the church. Please note that scholarship recipients may be announced to the church body unless you specify otherwise.

Applicants will be notified by May 31, 2024, of the Scholarship Committee decisions.

GUIDELINES FOR AWARDING OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

Applicants for the Scholarship shall meet the following requirements:

1. Shall be a student in good standing, or will have been admitted for enrollment, at Baylor University in Waco, or at another Baylor University campus.
2. Shall be a member of First Baptist Church, Denton, Texas, (including any of its campuses) with total length of membership of at least 12 months.
3. Complete the Application Form for the Scholarship and include the following:
 - (a) Basic information on the applicant and response to the requests on Page Two;
 - (b) A copy of his/her applicable transcripts (at least the last two years of schooling); and
 - (c) Letters of recommendation from two individuals who are not related to the applicant. One letter shall be from an active member of First Baptist Church, Denton, Texas, and the second shall be from someone who has been a part of the applicant's academic experience in high school or post-secondary studies.
