# **MEANING OF COLOUR BLACK**

Black is the opposite to white, therefore signifying maturity and proficiency in Tae Kwon-Do. It also indicates the wearers imperviousness to darkness and fear.

## INTERPRETATION OF THE PATTERN

Choong-Moo was the given name of the great Admiral Yi Sun-Sin of the Yi Dynasty. He was reputed to have built the precursor of the modern day submarine, an armoured battleship (Kobukson) in 1592. The pattern ends with a left handed attack to symbolise his regrettable death having no chance to show his true potential, restricted by the forced reservation of his lovalty to the King. 30 Moves

### **NEW MOVEMENTS IN THE PATTERN**

High Inward Knife Hand Strike Nopunde Anuro Sonkal Taerigi

Whilst bringing the back of the left hand in front of

forehead.

Twimyo Yop Cha Jirugi Flying Side Piercing Kick

High Reverse Knife Hand Inward Strike whilst Nopunde Sonkal Dung Anuro Taerigi bringing left hand underneath right elbow joint

Middle Side Piercing Kick

High Turning Kick

Middle Front Outer Forearm Block

High Side Back Fist Strike

Middle X-Knife Hand Checking Block

Double Upward Palm Block
