Circling the Wolf: What Kaleidoscopic Thinking Can Teach Us About Interconnection

FREE ONLINE EVENT

What can thinking omnivorously—porously moving between disciplines, and between self and subject—teach us about environmental interconnectedness? What began as an academic Environmental Studies project soon turned into a decade of obsession, where Berry researched stories about wolves both real and symbolic from around the world, leading to her celebrated nonfiction debut, *Wolfish: Wolf, Self, and the Stories We Tell About Fear* (Flatiron/Macmillan, 2023). *Wolfish* is a finalist Oregon Book Award and a semifinalist for the Pacific Northwest Book Award.

Erica Berry is a writer and teacher based in Portland, Oregon. Her essays appear in The Guardian, Orion, Outside, The Yale Review, The New York Times, The Atlantic, and others. Berry will teach two writing workshops at the Sitka Center in July 2024.
