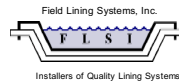
PERFORMING A JOB SAFETY ANALYSIS

JOB DESCRIPTION	POTENTIAL HAZARDS	ACTION AND OR PROCEDURE TO CONTROL OR ELIMINATE HAZARDS			
1 Liner Installation	Trips, Slips, Falls	Watch Anchor trenches. Use plywood Bridges or step in Step out of trench.			
2		Slope Areas - be aware of their steepness and use harness when applicable.			
3		Cords - make sure your footing is correct so you don't trip on cords.			
4	Wind Lifting Liner	If liner gets above your waist you are to let liner go. Also, do not slip your hand into strap			
5		the liner will force you into the air.			
6	Heat Stroke	Stay Hydrated. Drink 1/2 your body weight in ounces of water.			
7	Fire	Keep Generators on a pad of Liner and also keep Fire Extinguishers near every generator			
8		Fuel should be carried in Truck or at least 50' away from generators.			
9	Cuts	Cut away from yourself and assure that there are no people in your cut zone. No straight			
10		blades allowed.			
11	Pinch Points	watch pinchpoints and stay away from moving parts on forklift and other vehicles.			
12	Forklift	Do not go under suspended items or lifting area of Forklift.
