Fire Evacuation & Extinguisher Rules - 7/1/2020 - Ray Peebles of Cooley

Fire Extinguisher P.A.S.S. Procedure



“P” stands for “PULL” the pin.

“A” stands for “AIM” at the base of the fire.

“S” stands for “SQUEEZE” the handle of the portable extinguisher from a safe distance. T

“S” stands for “SWEEP” from side to side across the base of the fire as you approach, to make sure the extinguishing media completely covers the burning material and puts out the fire.

These four steps for using a portable extinguisher are simple, but can easily be forgotten when faced with an unexpected fire. But also remember that you should never, ever, attempt to put out a fire with an extinguisher if you are unsure about your ability to do so safely and effectively!

Evacuation Instructions: Remember to R.A.C.E.

Evacuation Instructions

- R** - Rescue and relocate anyone in immediate danger
- A** - Alert others by activating the building fire alarm
- C** - Confine the emergency by closing the doors
- E** - Evacuate immediately. Do not use elevators. Use stairs.
