Contractor workers and full time on-site inspectors receive proper safety training and are more aware of the on-site safety risks and safety requirements.

Site visitors may have a basic understanding of PPE and construction site safety, however this may not be part of their everyday lives and are likely not familiar with geomembrane construction and the site specific conditions.

Safety Risks May Include:

- · Slips and falls
- Wet side slopes
- Open trenches
- Excavations
- Construction equipment
- Deployment of materials
- Solvents
- High Heat equipment

Contractors Should Consider:

- Visitors wear proper shoes/boots
- Visitors wear safety vests and hard hats
- Visitors wear all designated PPE
- Wet side slopes
- Keep extra hard hats/vests/PPE in stock
- Require visitors to check in
- Educate visitor on site risks, traffic patterns
- Alert visitor site areas to avoid
