Safety Procedures:

- Minimum 2 persons on-site
- Operate with Buddy System
- Tensioned floating cover
- Walkways for steep side slopes
- Safety access ropes
- Caution around trough areas
- Project Safety Plan
- Daily Toolbox Safety Meetings





Proper Equipment:

- Proper footwear
- Flotation vest
- Sheathed & secured knife
- Float ring with rope

- Be very careful when operating on older aged floating covers
- Potential for weaker mechanical material properties
- Ensure adequate tensioning of floating covers
- Sinkholes that attract water
- Highly acidic or hazardous fluids
