NCRF S.T.E.A.M. Summer Camps Educate, Engage and Inspire Students

Young students explore challenging S.T.E.A.M. disciplines through hands-on activities.

WALNUT, CALIFORNIA – July 7, 2023 – National College Resources Foundation (NCRF) S.T.E.A.M. Initiative 2023 brings Summer Camps to the Tri-County area. The workshops focus on encouraging students to pursue a STEM/S.T.E.A.M. major (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, Agriculture, Aviation, Aerospace and Mathematics). There are four more camps for area youth, including three Free camps in partnership with local colleges and school districts.

NCRF is launching its inaugural S.T.E.A.M. Camp, the week of July 17 – July 21st from 9:30 – 1:30 pm at Reflexions Gaming in Covina, California for students entering 4th through 8th grades. This camp brings the S.T.E.A.M. acronym to life with a new topic each day, including science exploration, techno technology, engineering adventure, art, music and mathematics. Trained instructors will inspire 25 students to engage in hands-on activities and think outside of the box. There is a nominal fee of \$195 for a full week of guided, innovative learning, including all supplies, a nutritional snack and a field trip. As a bonus, students can stay after the camp and participate in esports competitions.

The 2nd Annual UC Riverside Engineering Camp for rising middle schoolers will be conducted the week of July 10th – 14th from 9 am – 2 pm at the UC Riverside Campus. Each day, students will explore a different engineering discipline, chemical, electrical, environmental and computer with hands-on activities. This FREE event will allow 45 students the opportunity to engage with other students, generate creative ideas, expand their knowledge base and explore the UC Riverside campus.

The Environmental Design Summer Camp for rising 7th and 8th graders will also be held during the week of July 10th – 13th at Cal Poly Pomona. This is an additional FREE opportunity for a select group of 30 students to design and learn about their world through architecture, landscape architecture, planning and design.

Another new offering this year is the NCRF/LUSD (Lynwood Unified School District) S.T.E.A.M. Camp the week of July 24th – 27th from 9:30 am – 1:30 pm in Lynwood, California for rising 7th and 8th graders. This four-day camp brings interactive activities in science, robotics and technology to the community at large. This unique experience is FREE and open to 30 students.
