#### **INSPIRING GRADUATES**

#### Chaffey College Commencement

Over 10,000 people including 2,500 graduates filled Toyota Arena in Ontario, CA on May 18, 2023 for Chaffey College's 106th Commencement ceremony. Dr. Theresa Price, Founder and CEO of the National College Resources Foundation and the Black College Expo™, served as keynote speaker for the event. ### 100 STUDENTS ENROLL IN DUAL ENROLLMENT PROGRAM NCRF Partners with HBCUs

To eliminate financial and geographic barriers to college degrees, NCRF and has entered an agreement with select Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) to offer an unprecedented Dual Enrollment to high school juniors and seniors across the nation. NCRF is the only-community-based organization in the country to offer this program. Though initially launched with Claflin University the beginning of Spring Semester 2023, NCRF signed agreements with Fisk University, Virginia University-Lynchburg, and Huston-Tillotson University, with Paul Quinn College and Texas Southern University coming on soon. Classes are transferable - the program is 100% online and is available at no cost through NCRF... Read More

#### NCRF's S.T.E.A.M. Program -Launches eSports Spirited Competition

In addition to STEAM's regular after school programs, NCRF has launched eSports. The STEAM Program hosted the first ever eSports Tournament in the area on April 22nd at Palomares Academy in Pomona. Fifty-seven students competed for a \$200 cash prize and a chance to be sponsored for a year to compete with the best in Super Smash! In all, six finalists were chosen for sponsorships. Families and supporters enjoyed watching the kids play a "New Sport" and everyone is looking forward to the 2nd annual tournament.





### STEAM-ing with Science for Elementary Students

In response to discovering that 4 out of 5 Latino and Black students are failing Science and 1/3 of K-3 students have chronic absenteeism, STEAM started a pilot program for 1st and 2nd graders at

Lexington Elementary in Pomona. The first six weeks of the program were well received. We look forward to instilling a love of STEAM in more youths.

### HBCU/Ivy League College Tour 2023

Lynwood Unified District's Equity, Access and Instructional Services Department and National College Resources Foundation (NCRF) recently celebrated African American students, their achievements, and unique experiences during the annual Rites of Passage ceremony as sixth and eighth graders geared up to promote to the next grade level and graduating seniors prepared to journey into the next chapter of their lives. In April, SAP hosted a weekend of Basketball Showcases and a Football Combine in Lynwood that featured a chance for over 400 unsigned seniors, community college and transfer portal student athletes to showcase their talent in front of HBCU college coaches.
