**Subject: Under \$20,000 option for the YIPPT Fund**

The TPC aims to respond to needs and priorities as determined by Yukon First Nations (YFNs). The TPC is pleased to advise that there is a streamlined option to apply for funding under the Yukon Indian Peoples Training Trust (YIPPT).

As of March 2022, Trustees have approved a motion to accept applications for \$20,000 or less from YIPPT with a signature or email from a YFN Manager or Director.
