## Try This Idea

- Buy a plush toy, or make your own, and sew a pouch onto it.
- 2. Fill the pouch with 1-3 age-appropriate activity cards, such as "Do your best dance move" or "Walk in a serpentine."
- 3. Position the Buddy between two classrooms and encourage your students to try to find it when they exit one of the classrooms.
- 4. One student draws an activity card from the pouch and leads their classmates in the activity as they move to their next class.
- 5. Encourage students to move the Hallway Buddy when they're done. It's fun to find a new hiding spot!
