- 3. Jeff's attitude has turned even more to "Lord Jesus, come quickly." (Rev 22:20, Rev 3:11) Have you seen that attitude among those who have suffered loss of a spouse?
- 4. Discuss Jeff's list of options when you lose someone close. (29:31)
- 5. Perhaps you've known someone who changed congregations after loss of a loved one, saying it was hard to be there. Compare that approach with Jeff's attitude (36:46)
