DEMAND WAIVER PROGRAM RIDER RATE SCHEDULE

(Name of Schedule)

AVAILABLE: In the retail distribution service territory of the District.

APPLICABLE: To any Customer which is served under the following rate schedules:

General Service Demand (Rate Codes 17 & 18) High Tension Service (Rate Codes 19 & 20)

To qualify for service under this Rate Schedule, a Customer must reduce their load by 100 kW or more during on-peak hours that have not been waived by the District. The District will determine the amount of the Customer's load reduction each month by reviewing the Customer's actual load profiles. Such review will only be performed by the District during months in which the peak loads used for billing the applicable retail billing district for that month occurred during on-peak hours that were not waived by the District under the provisions of this Rate Schedule. Customers who do not reduce their load by 100 kW or more in such months three (3) consecutive times will no longer qualify for service under this Rate Schedule and will be transferred to service under the OP-Rider Rate Schedule

BASE RATE: The base rates, charges and Base Rate Adjustments for electric service regularly applicable under the rate schedules listed above, with the addition of an administrative charge of \$190 per month.

WAIVER OF ON-PEAK DEMAND:

The provision entitled "Determination of Billing Demand" in each of the above rate schedules specifies the demand to be used for billing purposes. For Customers taking service under this rate schedule, the hours eligible for selection of the Customer's Billing Demand will be limited to those on-peak hours as specified in the Off-Peak Service Rider Rate Schedule (OP-Rider). The District may, from time to time, designate additional on-peak hours as off-peak solely for the purpose of a waiver of measured demands. In effect, these waived on-peak hours shall be considered off-peak for the purposes of determining the Customer's Billing Demand during the billing period. The District shall have the sole responsibility and authority for determining whether the measured demands shall be waived.

These additional off-peak hours will be subject to cancellation by the District if unforeseen events take place that reduce the available resources of the District to supply loads. Notice of cancellation

DEMAND WAIVER PROGRAM RIDER RATE SCHEDULE

(Name of Schedule)

by the District will necessitate that Customers respond promptly by reducing load, however, if the District has waived the demand during specified hours on the day of such emergency, the demand for such specified hours that day will still be waived for billing purposes.

DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND:

For Customers taking service under this rate schedule, the Billing Demands shall be determined as follows:

- (1) The Billing Demand for the monthly billing periods of June through September shall be determined from the higher of (a) or (b) below:
 - (a) The Customer's maximum integrated kilowatt load recorded during any thirty (30) minute period during on-peak hours that have not been waived of the current billing period or the three (3) monthly billing periods between June and September immediately preceding the current billing period. For example, the July billing demand would be chosen from the Customer's eligible demands recorded in July, June and the previous year's September and August.

Due to the fact that the District may waive all hours in the months of June and September, the above procedure will be modified for a customer's initial year on this rate schedule as follows:

- i. For Customers who begin taking service under this rate schedule in the months of October through June, the Billing Demand for the Customer's initial June billing period shall be based on the highest demand recorded in all June onpeak hours as determined by the OP-Rider. This June Billing Demand shall not be used in the subsequent three (3) months as a potential ratchet demand per paragraph 1.a above.
- ii. For Customers who begin taking service under this rate schedule in September, the Billing Demands for the Customer's initial September and June billing periods shall be based on the highest demand recorded in all June and September on-peak hours, respectively, as determined by the OP-Rider. These September and June Billing Demands shall not be used as potential ratchet demands per paragraph 1.a above.
