MEMORANDUM

RE: Local Law Creating a Town Tree Board

The Town has applied for an Urban Forestry Grant to aid in preservation and maintenance of the Town's tree inventory. The recent application was did not receive funding.

According to the Town's grant consultants J. O'Connell, the best way to enhance the chances of receiving funding for such a grant in the future, is to pursue designation of the Town as a "Tree City". In order to do so, the Town needs to establish and designate a Tree Board that would be the conduit of activities required to be undertaken by an Urban Forestry Grant. In the case of the Town of Somers, the most appropriate group to undertake these responsibilities is the Open Space Committee..

Michael Barnhart has agreed to have the Open Space Committee be designated as the Tree Board and Rick Morrissey has agreed to support the Board's effort should a consulting arborist be required to carry out some of its duties. The Tree Board would function in an advisory capacity to both the Highway Department and the Parks and Recreation Department whose responsibilities it is to carry out the physical activities necessary to maintain the Town's tree inventory.

To create the necessary Tree Board, I have drafted proposed legislation for consideration of approval by the Town Board.

The proposed legislation is attached for consideration by the Town Board. This item will be on the Town Board Agenda for October 8, 2020 for discussion, referral to the Somers Planning Board and the County Planning Board and setting a date for a public hearing.

Should the Town Board determine to move ahead with this amendment, it should take the following actions:

- Declare itself lead agency at its meeting of October 8, 2020
- Set date for public hearing of November 12, 2020 at meeting of October 8, 2020
- Refer the draft legislation to the Somers Planning Board and the County Planning Board

Once the public hearing is held and closed at the November 12, 2020 meeting, the Town Board can review the EAF Parts 1 and 2 and Narrative, comments, if any, from the Planning Boards and make a Negative Declaration and approve the proposed Town Code amendment as currently proposed or with any amendments as determined by the Board. This could happen at the November 12, 2020 meeting. All documents should be distributed to all interested agencies identified on the SEQR Distribution List.

Local Law No. of the ye	ar zuzu
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A Local Law establishing the Open Space Committee as the Tree Board in the Town of Somers.

Be It Enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Somers as follows:

<u>Section 120-1</u>. Chapter 120 of the Town of Somers Town Code shall be named "Tree Board".

Section 120-2. Purpose

This law is enacted to designate the Open Space Committee of the Town of Somers as the official Tree Board for the Town in order to achieve the following purposes:

- A. Provide recommendations to the Parks and Recreation Department and Highway Department who are responsible for management and care of the Town's trees, parks and open spaces regarding preservation of the Town's urban canopy
- B. Promote efficient and cost-effective management of the Town's community forest
- C. Work to establish and maintain the maximum sustainable tree cover including age and species in order to protect and enhance the environment and the character of the Town
- D. Foster community support through regular educational outreach, and encourage good citizen tree management practices through knowledge sharing.

Section 120-3. Legislative Authority.

This article is adopted pursuant to the authority granted by the Municipal Home Rule Law and shall supersede any provision of State Law which is inconsistent herewith.

Section 120-4. Definitions.

As used in this chapter, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

ARBORIST- Trained specialist certified by the International Society of Arboriculture or one of its chapters or other nationally recognized arboricultural organizations with expertise in tree management.

OPEN SPACE COMMITTEE - The Open Space Committee advises the Town on preserving and protecting municipal trees, parks, land and undeveloped spaces and has assumed some responsibilities in an advisory capacity of the former Conservation Board.

PARK - Includes land designated as a park pursuant to New York State statutes as well as areas such as playgrounds, pools, or other recreational facilities within the Town.

PUBLIC PLACES - Includes all grounds owned, leased, or controlled by the Town of Somers.

PUBLIC TREE - Any woody plant, located on municipal property or within the municipal right-of-way, having at least one well-defined trunk and at least 2 1/2 inches in diameter measured at a height of 6 inches above the natural grade and having a clearly defined crown.

STREET TREE - Any tree, shrub, bush, or other woody vegetation on land lying between property lines on either side of all streets, avenues or roads, such as the municipal right-of-way.

TREE CITY, USA – A program sponsored by the National Arbor Day Foundation in cooperation with the USDA Forest Service and the National Association of State Forester which gives recognition to communities for providing a basic level of human and financial resources to manage their community forests.

TREE WORK - Includes, but is not limited to, pruning, shaping, thinning, cabling, stump removal, root pruning, topping, fertilizing, removing, planting, and spraying for insect and disease control, of a tree.

Section 120-5. Tree Board Members

A. Membership of the Tree Board shall consist of the members of the Open Space Committee as appointed by the Somers Town Board. Secretary to the Tree Board shall be the Secretary to the Open Space Committee.

Section 120-6. Responsibilities of the Tree Board

The responsibilities of the Tree Board shall be as follows:

A. Accountability

- (1) The Tree Board shall submit an annual report of their actions and activities to the Town of Somers Town Board.
- (2) The Tree Board shall advise and assist with the annual renewal of the Arbor Day Foundation Tree City designation advise and coordinate the submission of future Urban Forestry Grant applications.

B. Review and Make Recommendation for New Tree Planting

(1) The Tree Board shall advise other boards and departments regarding the location of planting of new trees on municipally owned land.

C. Environmental Education and Awareness

(1) Coordinate and promote the Town's annual Arbor Day celebration and activities. Support local schools, libraries, and community centers in offering environmental education programs and programing relating to tree planting and preservation.

D. Best management Practices for Tree Care and Maintenance

- (1) The Open Space Committee shall advise on the species and variety of trees to be planted, including the size, height, and width of the trees, and expected maximum growth.
- (2) The Committee will select and consult with an arborist to conduct Town wide tree inventories, advise on tree management plans, tree planting, maintenance, and education programming.
- (3) The Town's Parks and Recreation Department and the Highway Department will consider the advice of the Open Space Committee when they physically manage the care of the Town's trees, parks, and open spaces.

Section 120-7. Severability.

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this Local Law, or the application thereof to any person or circumstance, shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof.

<u>Section 120-8</u>. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.

Schedule A Insurance and Indemnification

1. Prior to commencing work, the Contractor shall obtain, at its own cost and expense, the required insurance from insurance companies licensed and admitted in the State of New York, carrying a Best's financial rating of A or better, and shall provide evidence of such insurance to the Town of Somers ("Town"), subject to the approval of the Town. The policies or certificates thereof shall provide that thirty days prior to cancellation or material change in the policy, notices of same shall be given to the Supervisor, Town of Somers by registered mail, return receipt requested, for all of the following stated insurance policies. Any adjustments in the coverage's set forth below will require the prior written approval of the Town. All notices shall name the Contractor and identify the Agreement.

If at any time any of the policies required herein shall be or become unsatisfactory to the Town, as to form or substance, or if a company issuing any such policy shall be or become unsatisfactory to the Town, the Contractor shall upon notice to that effect from the Town, promptly obtain a new policy, submit the same to the Town for approval and submit a certificate thereof. Upon failure of the Contractor to furnish, deliver and maintain such insurance, the Agreement, at the election of the Town, may be declared suspended, discontinued or terminated. Failure of the Contractor to take out, maintain, or the taking out or maintenance of any required insurance, shall not relieve the Contractor from any liability under the Agreement, nor shall the insurance requirements be construed to conflict with or otherwise limit the contractual obligations of the Contractor concerning defense and indemnification. All property losses shall be made payable to and adjusted with the Town.

In the event that claims, for which the Town may be liable, in excess of the insured amounts provided herein are filed by reason of any operations under the Agreement, the amount of excess of such claims or any portion thereof, may be withheld from payment due or to become due the Contractor until such time as the Contractor shall furnish such additional security covering such claims in form satisfactory to the Town of Somers.

- 2. The Contractor shall provide proof of the following insurance coverage:
- (a) Workers' Compensation. Certificate form C-105.2 or State Fund Insurance Company form U-26.3 or accord certificate is required for proof of compliance with the New York State Workers' Compensation Board form DB-120.1 is required for proof compliance with the New York State Disability Benefits Law. Location of operation shall be "All locations in Westchester County, New York."

- (f) If work involves use or removal of hazardous materials, Contractor shall carry and provide evidence of insurance showing pollution coverage with a limit of not less than \$5,000,000.00. Policy shall be endorsed to name the Town of Somers as additional insured.
- 3. All policies and certificates of insurance of the Contractor shall be subject to and shall contain the following clauses:

- (a) Insurers shall have no right to recovery or subrogation against the Town of Somers (including its employees and their agents and agencies) it being the intention of the parties that the insurance policies so effected shall protect both parties and be primary coverage for any and all losses covered by the above-described insurance.
- (b) The clause "other insurance provisions" in a policy in which the Town of Somers is named as an insured, shall not apply to the Town of Somers.

All contracts involving the use of explosives and demolition shall provide the above coverage with elimination of the XCU exclusion from the policy, or proof that XCU is covered.

- (d) Automobile Liability Insurance with a minimum limit of liability per occurrence of \$1,000,000 for bodily injury and a minimum limit of \$1,000,000 per occurrence for property damage or a combined single limit of \$2,000,000. This insurance shall include a bodily injury and property damage the following coverages.
 - (i) Owned automobiles.
 - (ii) Hired automobiles.
 - (iii) Non-owned automobiles.
- (e) Umbrella Liability with a minimum limit of liability per occurrence of \$2,000,000.00 per occurrence and \$2,000,000.00 aggregate.
- (f) If work involves use or removal of hazardous materials, Contractor shall carry and provide evidence of insurance showing pollution coverage with a limit of not less than \$5,000,000.00. Policy shall be endorsed to name the Town of Somers as additional insured.
- 3. All policies and certificates of insurance of the Contractor shall be subject to and shall contain the following clauses:
- (a) Insurers shall have no right to recovery or subrogation against the Town of Somers (including its employees and their agents and agencies) it being the intention of the parties that the insurance policies so effected shall protect both parties and be primary coverage for any and all

losses covered by the above-described insurance.

- (b) The clause "other insurance provisions" in a policy in which the Town of Somers is named as an insured, shall not apply to the Town of Somers.
- (c) The insurance companies issuing the policy or policies shall have no recourse against the Town of Somers (including its agents and agencies as aforesaid) for payment of any premiums or for assessments under any form of policy.
- (d) Any and all deductibles in the above described insurance policies shall be assumed by and be for the account of, and at the sole risk of, the Contractor.
- 4. The Contractor shall protect, defend, indemnify and hold the Town of Somers, its boards, officers, employees and agents free and harmless from and against any and all losses, penalties, damages, settlements, costs, charges, professional fees or other expenses or liabilities of every kind and character arising out of or relating to any and all claims, liens, demands, obligations, actions, proceedings or causes of action of every kind and character in connection with or arising directly or indirectly out of this agreement and/or the performance hereof; without limiting the generality of the foregoing, any and all such claims, etc., relating to personal injury, death, damage to property, defects in materials or workmanship, actual or alleged infringement of any patent, trademark, copyright (or application for any thereof) or of any other tangible or intangible personal or property right, or any actual or alleged violation of any applicable statute, ordinance, administrative order, rule or regulation, decree of any court, shall be included in the indemnity hereunder. The Contractor further agrees to investigate, handle, respond to, provide defense for and defend any such claims, etc., at his sole expense and agreed to bear all other costs and expenses related thereto, even if it (claims, etc.), is groundless, false or fraudulent. In any case in which such indemnification would violate Section 5-322.1 of the New York General Obligations Law, or any other applicable legal prohibition, the foregoing provisions concerning indemnification shall not be construed to indemnify the Town for damage arising out of bodily injury to persons or damage to property caused by or resulting from the sole negligence of the Town, or its employees. This paragraph shall survive any termination or completion of performance of this Agreement.

Schedule A Insurance and Indemnification

1. Prior to commencing work, the Contractor shall obtain, at its own cost and expense, the required insurance from insurance companies licensed and admitted in the State of New York, carrying a Best's financial rating of A or better, and shall provide evidence of such insurance to the Town of Somers ("Town"), subject to the approval of the Town. The policies or certificates thereof shall provide that thirty days prior to cancellation or material change in the policy, notices of same shall be given to the Supervisor, Town of Somers by registered mail, return receipt requested, for all of the following stated insurance policies. Any adjustments in the coverage's set forth below will require the prior written approval of the Town. All notices shall name the Contractor and identify the Agreement.


If at any time any of the policies required herein shall be or become unsatisfactory to the Town, as to form or substance, or if a company issuing any such policy shall be or become unsatisfactory to the Town, the Contractor shall upon notice to that effect from the Town, promptly obtain a new policy, submit the same to the Town for approval and submit a certificate thereof. Upon failure of the Contractor to furnish, deliver and maintain such insurance, the Agreement, at the election of the Town, may be declared suspended, discontinued or terminated. Failure of the Contractor to take out, maintain, or the taking out or maintenance of any required insurance, shall not relieve the Contractor from any liability under the Agreement, nor shall the insurance requirements be construed to conflict with or otherwise limit the contractual obligations of the Contractor concerning defense and indemnification. All property losses shall be made payable to and adjusted with the Town.

In the event that claims, for which the Town may be liable, in excess of the insured amounts provided herein are filed by reason of any operations under the Agreement, the amount of excess of such claims or any portion thereof, may be withheld from payment due or to become due the Contractor until such time as the Contractor shall furnish such additional security covering such claims in form satisfactory to the Town of Somers.

- 2. The Contractor shall provide proof of the following insurance coverage:
- (a) Workers' Compensation. Certificate form C-105.2 or State Fund Insurance Company form U-26.3 or accord certificate is required for proof of compliance with the New York State Workers' Compensation Law. State Workers' Compensation Board form DB-120.1 is required for proof compliance with the New York State Disability Benefits Law. Location of operation shall be "All locations in Westchester County, New York."

Where an applicant claims to not be required to carry either a Workers' Compensation Policy or Disability Benefits' Policy, or both, a temporary permit may be issued if the employer completes form C-105.2 in duplicate. A copy of form C-105.2 is sent to the Workers' Compensation Board, Information Unit for investigation and report.)

If the employer is self-insured for Worker's Compensation, he should present a certificate

WSP, USA is responding to the comments provided in the September 3, 2020 memorandum that was prepared by Woodard & Curran. The comments and responses are presented below and the attached application has been updated to address the comments.

Comment No. 1

The Applicant shall explain how drilling spoils and well yield test water will be managed to avoid impacts to the wetland and streams.

Response:

The drilling spoils will be collected in the tailings pit which will be located on the downslope side of each drilling site. Erosion and sediment controls will be installed on the downslope side of each tailing pit to collect any sediment that may flow out of the tailings pit. The yield test water from the short-term and 72-hour yield test will be diverted to the onsite pond and discharged close to the pond on plywood, or a tarp, to allow for sheet flow into the pond which will eliminate the concern of any erosion from the discharge water. This procedure is acceptable to the NYSDEC.

Comment No. 2

The Applicant shows approximate limits for the work area for each of the proposed wells. The Applicant shall clarify on the plans how the disturbed areas will be restored.

Response:

Plate 4 has been included and displays the proposed drilling sites within the NYSDEC buffer and this plate identified the approximate limit of the work area. In addition, a note has been added to Plate 2 to indicate that the disturbed areas will be restored using a native seed mix. Any brush or trees removed as part of the drilling process will be chipped and removed from the wetland buffer area. No debris will be disposed of within the wetland buffer area.

Comment No. 3

The presence of PFOA/PFOS is concerning given the location of the existing wells in the Town's Groundwater Overlay Protection District. The Applicant shall provide a summary of PFOA/PFOS testing and what has been done to identify the potential source of this contamination.

Response:

The water quality data from the recently drilled Well 2C indicates that PFOS/PFOA were either non-detect or below the laboratory minimum detection limit. With regard to the request to provide a summary of the PFOS/PFOA testing, this summary will be provided by New York American Water Company in a separate report.

Comment No. 4

The Applicant shall furnish copies of the required NYSDEC and WCDOH permits prior to issuance of the environment permit.

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PROJECT DESCRIPTION



PROJECT PLAN

The New York American Water Company (NY American) would like to conduct exploratory drilling on the Willows Homeowners Association (WHA) property located on Krystal Drive, Somers, New York to drill a new bedrock water-supply well. The WHA property is adjacent to NY American's Dykeer water-supply system (Dykeer). This exploratory drilling is being proposed to potentially increase the available water-supply capacity and address elevated chloride and perfluoro octane sulfonates and perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOS/PFOA) concentrations in the Dykeer water-supply system. It is believed the source of the elevated chloride in the water supply is from onsite road salting activities and prior onsite road salt storage while the source of the PFOS/PFOA is unknown at this time.

The attached site plan identifies four prospective drilling sites. One location (Well 2C) is located outside of the New York Stated Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) wetland buffer and three remaining prospective drilling sites (1A, 2A and 2A Alternate) are located within the NYSDEC wetland buffer. Based on a review of the geologic maps of the region, the locations of the proposed test wells were selected based on fracture trace patterns. Wells drilled on or near intersecting fractures can significantly increase the potential yield of a well. All the locations that have been identified are considered geologically favorable, less likely to be impacted by road salting activities and are a significant distance from the existing production wells which would be expected to minimize the potential for interference between the existing wells and the proposed wells. The actual number of wells that would be constructed on the property would be dependent on the yields obtained from the proposed wells as they are drilled; however, no more than three wells area anticipated, Well 2C and two wells within the NYSDEC buffer. In all cases, any drilling spoils generated during the drilling process will be collected within a tailing pit that will be excavated on the downslope side of the proposed drilling site. Erosion and sediment controls will be installed on the downslope side of each tailings pit to collect any sediment that may flow out of the pit. In addition, all disturbed areas associated with drilling operations will be restored to their original conditions with a native seed mix and any brush or trees that are removed will be chipped and removed from the wetland buffer. No debris will be disposed of within the wetland or the wetland buffer. A description of the proposed subsurface investigation is presented below.

The drilling approach for NY American consists of two options in the following order.

Option 1: Drill Location 2 C

The preferred drilling site is Location 2C. This location is readily accessible with a drilling rig and requires minimal land surface preparation. In addition, no trees would need to be removed to access the drilling site; however, pruning of tree limbs will be necessary to allow for drilling.

The size of the activity area for Well 2C will be limited to the access route for the drill rig which will require the placement of filter fabric and gravel to level the drilling site. The drill rig is approximately 10 feet wide by 35 feet long and weights approximately 75,000 pounds. Therefore, the test well) would be drilled when weather conditions are favorable and the land surface is dry. In addition, a work area of approximately 20 feet around the drilling site will be needed for drilling the well and this

will include the excavation of a drill tailings pit that will measure approximately 3 feet wide by 5 feet in length and 3 feet in depth.

Option 2: Drill Locations 1A, 2A or 2A Alternate

NY American has recently filed for a wetland disturbance permit from the NYSDEC to drill the locations within the wetland buffer. Considering the wetland disturbance permit was recently submitted, it may be approximately two to four months before we receive comments on our application or an approval. While three prospective drilling sites are located within the NYSDEC wetland buffer, Location 2A is preferred; however, it is located within Wetland F-76 in order to meet the New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH) sanitary setback requirements. Because it is located within the wetland, Location 2A may not be approved by the NYSDEC. Please note that if we intend to drill at these locations, we will supply an addendum to this project description that provides specific details on how each site would be accessed, the number of trees that would need to be removed and what erosion controls are proposed.

The Dykeer system consists of four water-supply wells (Well 1, Well 3 (aka Well 2), Well 4 and Well 6), a 90,000-gallon underground atmospheric storage tank, water treatment equipment and repressurization transfer pumps (including a fire pump). The Dykeer system serves the WHA complex and the average daily demand for the Willows, based on 2018 operational reports, is 19,113 gpd (gallons per day) and the maximum daily demand is 32,000 gpd. The NYSDEC permitted rates (permit issued in 2005) for Well 1, Well 3, Well 4 and Well 6 are 5 gpm (gallons per minute), 16 gpm, 5 gpm and 15 gpm, respectively. The current well yields based on communication with the Water Operator are 5 to 6 gpm for Well 1, 5 gpm for Well 3, 1.2 gpm for Well 4 and 8 gpm for Well 6 for a combined capacity of 20.2 gpm or about 29,088 gpd. These rates marginally meet the maximum day capacity of 32,000 gpd (from 2018 operational reports) if all of the wells are pumping concurrently including some water available from storage.

Recent water samples collected from the production wells and the entry point to the distribution system in the April 2020 reported chloride concentrations in excess of the maximum contaminant level (MCL) of 250 mg/L (milligrams per liter). NY American received a Notice of Violation (NOV) associated with the exceedance of the chloride MCL at the entry point to the distribution system in April 2020. The table below contains a summary of the available chloride concentrations reported for samples collected from the entry point, production wells and surface water in the pond near the production wells starting in November 2017.

In addition, recent water quality detected PFOS/PFOA at concentrations above 10 ppt (parts per trillion) which exceeds the New York State (NYS) maximum contaminant level (MCL) of 10 ppt for PFOS and 10 ppt for PFOA.

The goal of drilling new wells within the WHA complex would be to find water with chloride and PFOS/PFOA concentrations suitable for use in dilution of the existing wells. The yield from the new well(s) would be added to the existing well capacities, resulting in an overall increase in yield for the Dykeer water system. NY American has obtained authorization from the WHA to drill the test wells at the proposed locations. If a viable well is drilled, NY American will negotiate ownership of the well.

Bedrock Well Program

The bedrock wells would be drilled using the air-rotary drilling method. The test wells would be drilled in the WHA property at the locations shown on the attached plans. The bedrock wells would be drilled in accordance with the NYSDOH and Westchester County Health Department (WCDH) regulations for public water-supply wells. Although the overburden material consists of till (mix of sand, silt and clay) which acts as a semi-confining unit, the wells would be constructed by installing and grouting in place a minimum of 100 feet of 6-inch diameter casing in order to minimize potential impact to nearby wetlands. The test well(s) would be drilled to a minimum depth of 600 feet, if a suitable yield is not encountered at a shallower depth. A hydrogeologist would analyze the water-production data obtained to 500 feet and decide whether to continue drilling beyond that depth.

Each test well would be completed with a locking, steel protective stick-up surface casing set in concrete that would be welded shut after all of the testing is completed.

Assuming a total well depth of 600 ft bg, WSP estimates that each test well would require three to four days to drill and construct, depending on the drilling conditions encountered. In addition to the WCDH well site application, the well driller will file the well logs after completion. A Dig Safely mark-out will be requested prior to the start of drilling.

Any wells that are drilled and determined to have insufficient yield would either be maintained as water-level monitor wells equipped with water-tight caps or be abandoned in accordance with NYSDOH and WCDH protocols.

Well Development and Testing

Each of the completed test wells would be developed and tested by a WSP hydrogeologist. The new well would be developed immediately upon completion of drilling. The development would be performed by purging a minimum of six standing volumes of water from the new test well. Following the well development activities, the well would be pumped for a period of four hours to determine a preliminary well yield and determine if the next proposed test well should be drilled. In addition, a water sample from any bedrock well would be collected for analysis for the chloride concentration. If the laboratory results indicate an exceedance of the chloride MCL, the well may not be subjected to a 72-hour pumping test.

Assuming the preliminary yield and water quality are acceptable, the bedrock well(s) would be subject to a yield test that would be designed and implemented in accordance with the NYSDEC August 2018 "Pumping Test Procedures for Water Withdrawal Applications". The pumping test would be




run for a minimum of 72 hours and until stabilized yield and water-level drawdown has been demonstrated. The 72-hour pumping test will include water level monitoring of select offsite private potable supplies to determine potential drawdown impacts. Fluctuations in surface water stage for surface waters (including wetlands) within 1,000 feet of the pumping test would be monitored in piezometers that would be installed as part of the 72-hour pumping test. In addition, water samples would be collected near the end of the test and submitted for analysis for parameters listed in the NYSDOH Sanitary Code Part 5, Subpart 5-1. Microscopic Particulate Analysis (MPA) samples would also be collected from the wells (Locations 2C, 1A, and/or 2A) because each of these proposed wells are located within 200 feet of a surface-water body. Physical parameter measurements of pH, temperature and conductivity would also be collected from the discharge water and similar physical parameter data would be collected from the nearby surface water for use in comparison and determination of potential Groundwater Under Direct Influence (GWUDI) risk. Based on the geologic conditions observed, the results from the 72-hour yield test and the water-quality results of the investigation, WSP would evaluate the feasibility of developing a bedrock water supply. In addition, all water generated during any short-term and 72-hour yield test will be diverted towards the onsite pond. Based on the yields of the existing production wells, the anticipated yield for a new well is less than 20 gpm. The water generated from the test would be discharged in close proximity to the pond. Plywood, or a tarp laid down at the discharge point would be used to allow for sheet flow into the pond which will eliminate the concern of any erosion from the discharge water. This procedure is acceptable to the NYSDEC.






