Situation

AmeriHealth Caritas District of Columbia, a Managed Medicaid plan in Washington, DC serving over 100K members, was interested in assessing their social impact programs.

These programs were designed to help manage costs and improve outcomes for high-cost members, with a specific focus on clinically complex members with a high social risk exposure. AmeriHealth was interested in quantifying the extent to which existing programs and partnerships were able to reduce utilization and costs as well as improve quality metrics.

Solution

Socially Determined conducted an evaluation of 12 of AmeriHealth's social impact programs by adding historical claims and programmatic data into their Social Risk Intelligence

platform, SocialScape® to deliver unmatched social risk insights. The analysis focused on key outcomes metrics identified by AmeriHealth, including total cost of care, emergency medical service utilization, low acuity Emergency Department visits, and readmission rates.

Results

Socially Determined's impact evaluation generated a consistent view of program impact across all 12 intervention programs. This provided AmeriHealth leadership with actionable insights to inform strategic decisions for ongoing investments in these programs, including refining, scaling, or suspending programs.
