

HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN UPDATE

Wichita County, in collaboration with the cities of Burkburnett, Cashion Community, Electra, Iowa Park, Pleasant Valley, and Wichita Falls, is updating the Hazard Mitigation Plan. The Plan Update will address natural hazards that affect the area and the goal of the Plan Update is to minimize or eliminate the long-term risk to human life and property from known hazards through effective mitigation.
