Timeline of the Challenge Day:

Session 1: Super Skills

Learners explore the essential skills by taking part in a series of mini challenges.

☐ *Option A: run this session as pre-teaching before the day, focusing on all eight skills. (50 min)*
☐ *Option B: run this session on the morning of the Challenge Day, focusing on just two skills. (20 min)*


Session 2: Evidence Examination

Learners discuss different clues and how they impact the case.

Learners analyse a sound clip taken from the crime scene.

Learners match the suspects' prints to those found at the crime scene.
