GOAL 1: NO POVERTY

- Have averaged over 300 direct jobs in economically distressed areas and an estimated 1,500 indirect jobs.
- Brought new industries to a rural distressed region and worked with local contractors to rehabilitate properties for third party organizations to incubate new opportunities.
- Average pay for our staff is 200% above the average minimum wage in the region.
- Worked with third parties to repurpose prior thermal coal properties to create new jobs in the region.

- Acquired five companies out of bankruptcy and utilized new age management and technology to restructure the assets to be productive and sustainable for the future.
