When To Watch	Some buildings are required by law to have fire alarm and automatic sprinkler systems. If either of these systems go down for more than four hours in a 24-hour period, NFPA 101 2018 Ed. Section 9 Paragraph 9.6.1.5 and NFPA 72, NFPA 13 requires the building to be evacuated or a fire watch to be established. Local authorities are to be notified of the equipment failure and subsequent fire watch. The fire watch must be maintained until the fire alarm and sprinkler systems are again properly functioning.						
What to Watch	Members of a fire watch must regularly and thoroughly check all parts of a building that are affected by the fire alarm and sprinkler failures. This includes attics, crawl spaces, storage rooms, resident rooms, employee break rooms and concealed areas. Watchers are required to keep a log sheet of the rounds they make while on fire watch. This shall be every 60 minutes. The log is usually kept in a central location to make it easily accessible and to verify that it is not being tampered with.						
Who Watches	Fire watchers should be familiar with the watching. In addition to the facility's essenbuld know where manual fire alarms located and be able to use them if necessable to use communication devices, such out fire watch log sheets. Fire watch personnel must perform continuous tours such that each room in their assigned area is									
checked at not less than 60-minute intervals. The first entry in this log must be made within 60									
minutes of the start of the fire watch and every 60 minutes thereafter. Times must be recorded									
using the 24-hour clock and initialed. Any problems found during the fire watch must be									
documented (along with the time found and initialed) and reported to the head of maintenance for									
immediate correction.
