Ethanol is assertive on the nose, with hints of tobacco and caramel filtering through. On the palate heavy sweet notes of caramel and vanilla saturate the senses with bursts of tobacco and leather, along with a touch of smoky char and hint of custard rounding things out. Spice pops in the finish, along with a trace of smokiness leading to a lingering brown sugar sweetness.

HENRY MCKENNA SINGLE BARREL

Traditional aromas of caramel and vanilla play against a backdrop of seasoned oak. These aromas transform into tastes on the palate, finding balance with rye spice and a pop of brown sugar. Its medium length finish allows the flavors to taper off elegantly, with a hint a leather creeping in to add a layer of complexity.

Citrus and oak aromas give way to a simplistically sweet palate with easily identifiable flavors of honey, brown sugar, oak, and pepper. It ends on sweet notes of toffee and honey with traces of vanilla and leather rounding things out.

Aromas of oak, citrus fruit, and a hint of spice atop a bed of caramel invite a sip. While a bit timid, a wide array of flavors along with a nice, creamy mouthfeel create a delicate experience on the palate. The intensity of those flavors ramps up in the finish, with oak, summer fruits, and caramel against a backdrop of rye spice and seasoned oak.
