

Re-Opening Plan Update

Re-Opening Survey Results

Out of the over 400 Submissions received...

- 91% of families are watching the online service each week, but only 33% are watching with another household or family.
- While 57% said they would plan to attend an in person Sunday service, 74% said they would like the church move slowly towards re-opening.
- In general, it is almost a 50/50 split between those who are eager to re-open and those who are hesitant.

Guiding Questions

As we move forward, we must consider the following...

- 1. Inclusion Does our plan enable us minister to the greatest number of people who call SHC home and those who are needing help throughout our community?
- 2. Quality Will this allow us to maintain a level of excellence in what we produce?
- 3. Margin Does our plan allow our staff to still get time away this summer?
- 4. Pastoral Care Does our plan include opportunities for our people to get face time with our pastors and staff?
- 5. *Fellowship* Does our plan include opportunities for people to gather together for fellowship (welcome, worship, word, witness)?
- 6. Safety Does this reflect consideration of the safety of all individuals that would be gathering together for any form of ministry?



We will not meet in person for Sunday services before September.

We will continue to record and post Sunday messages to be viewed online in homes through August.



Home Groups

We will strengthen and organize our home groups.

This will include increasing the number of home groups, training home group leaders, and providing more resources.



Fireside Prayer

We will organize several Wednesday gatherings.

Salem Heighters and their families will be able to interact with the pastors, staff and each other.


Gatherings will be hosted outside around fire pits and will require an RSVP.
