

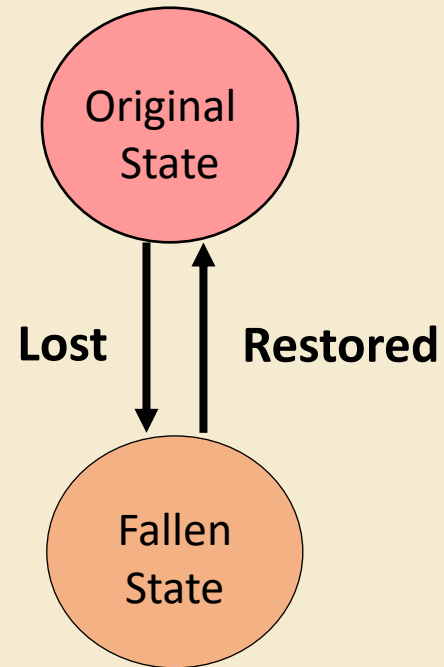

# The Purpose of Restoration



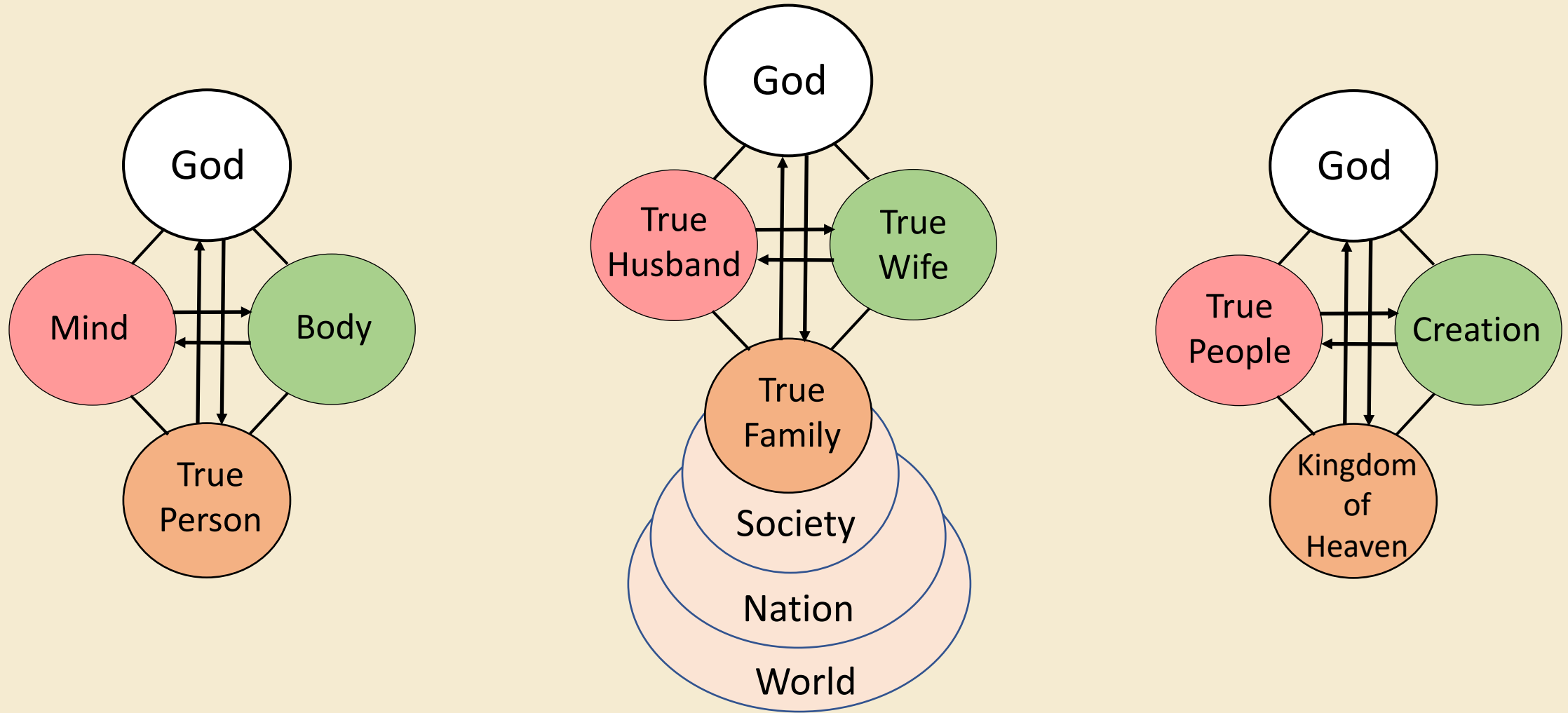
*God is not human, that he should lie,

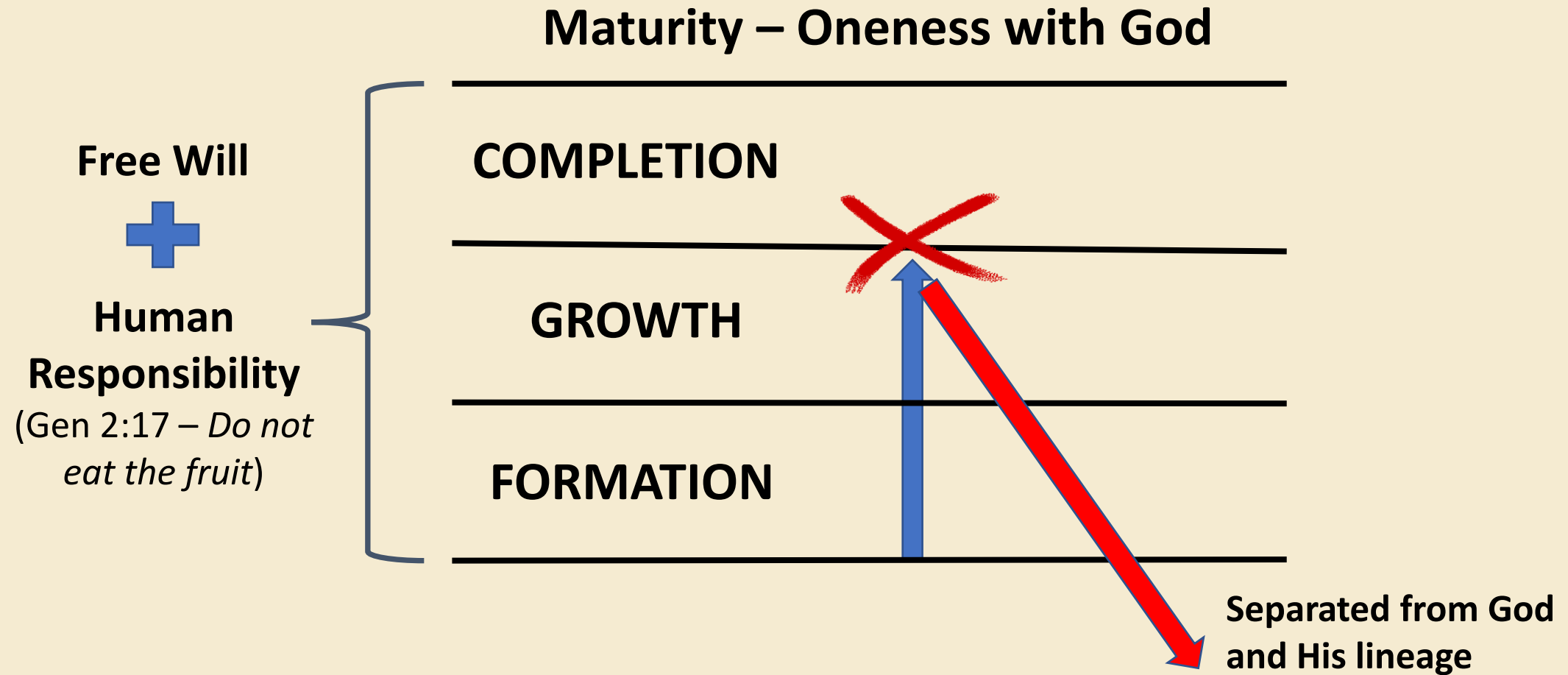
# The Principles of Restoration are Based on the Principles of Creation

- For God's Purpose of Creation to be fulfilled, His original plan for the Garden of Eden must be accomplished.
- Since the Fall, God has worked His providence to prepare for the coming of Christ – the new Adam.
- Through Christ, God desires to restore fallen human beings from our sinful state as children of Satan to our original state as children of God.
- The principles by which He has worked to restore humankind are the same as His Principles of Creation.

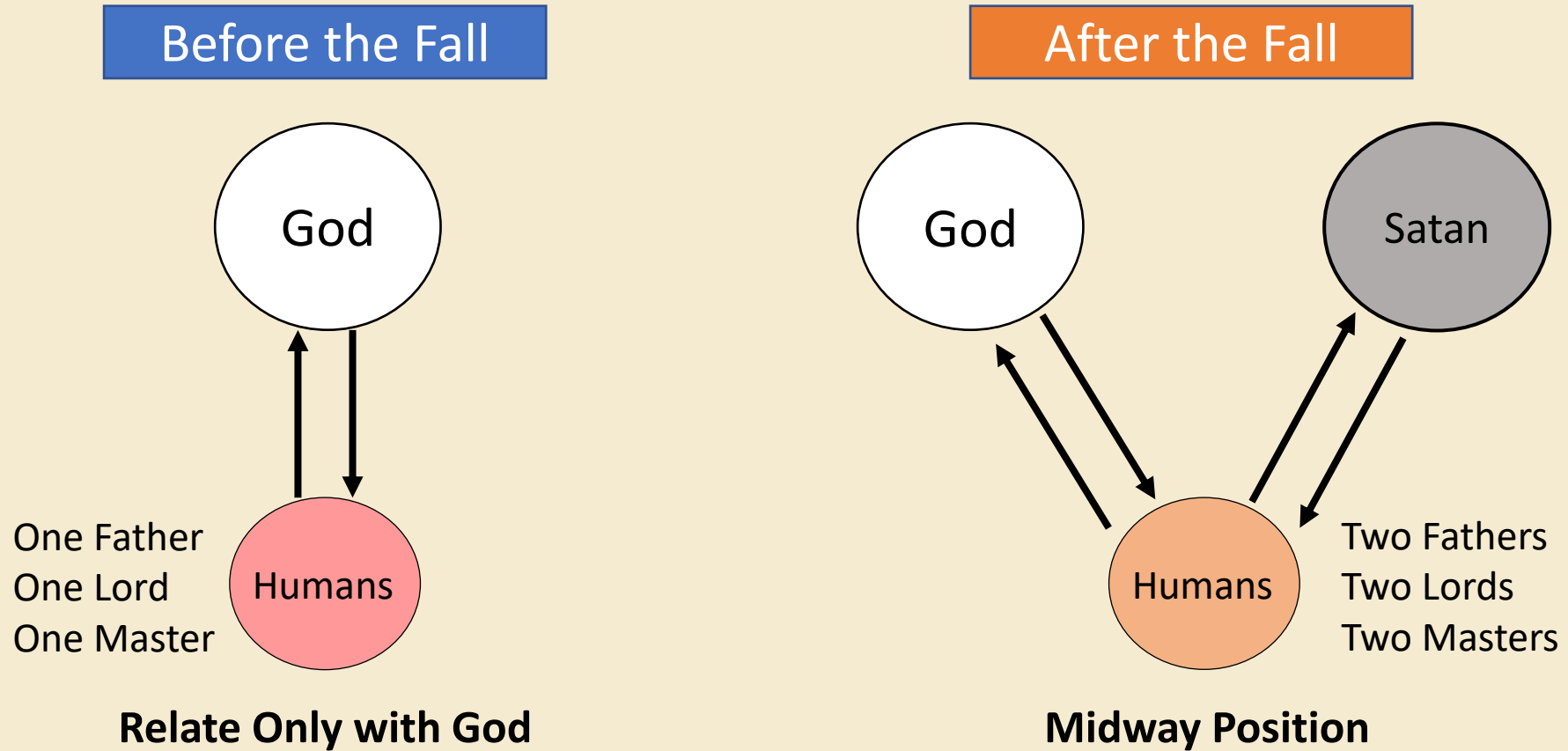






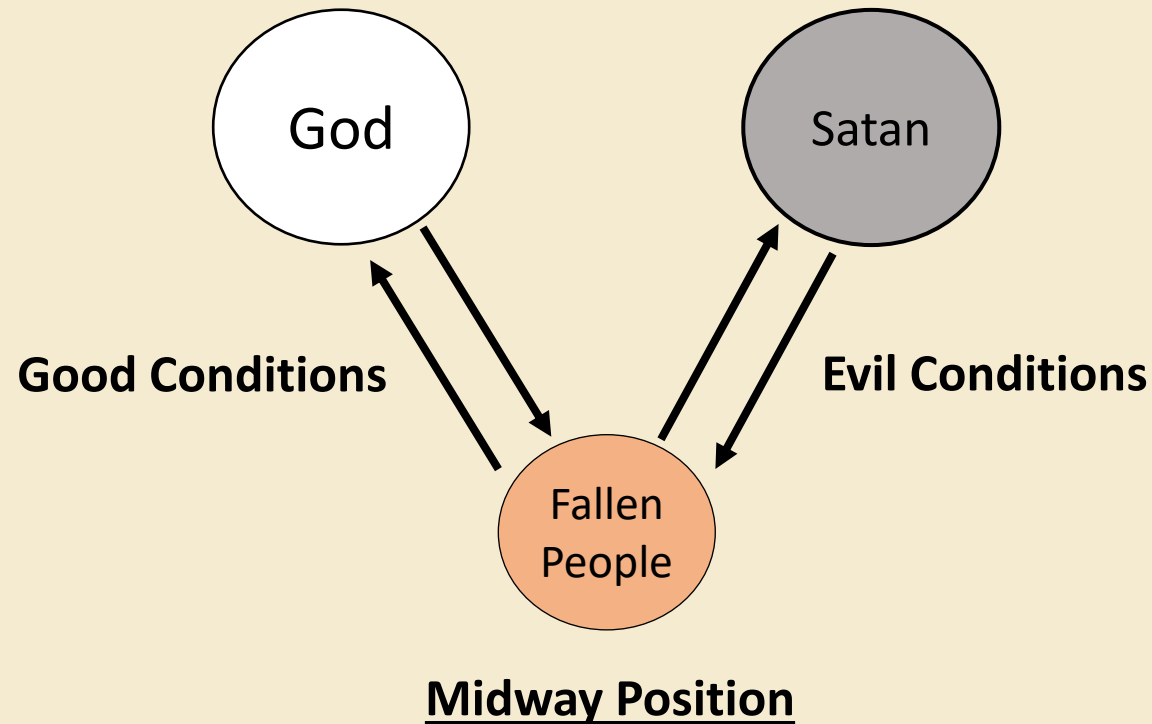


# The Position of Fallen Man

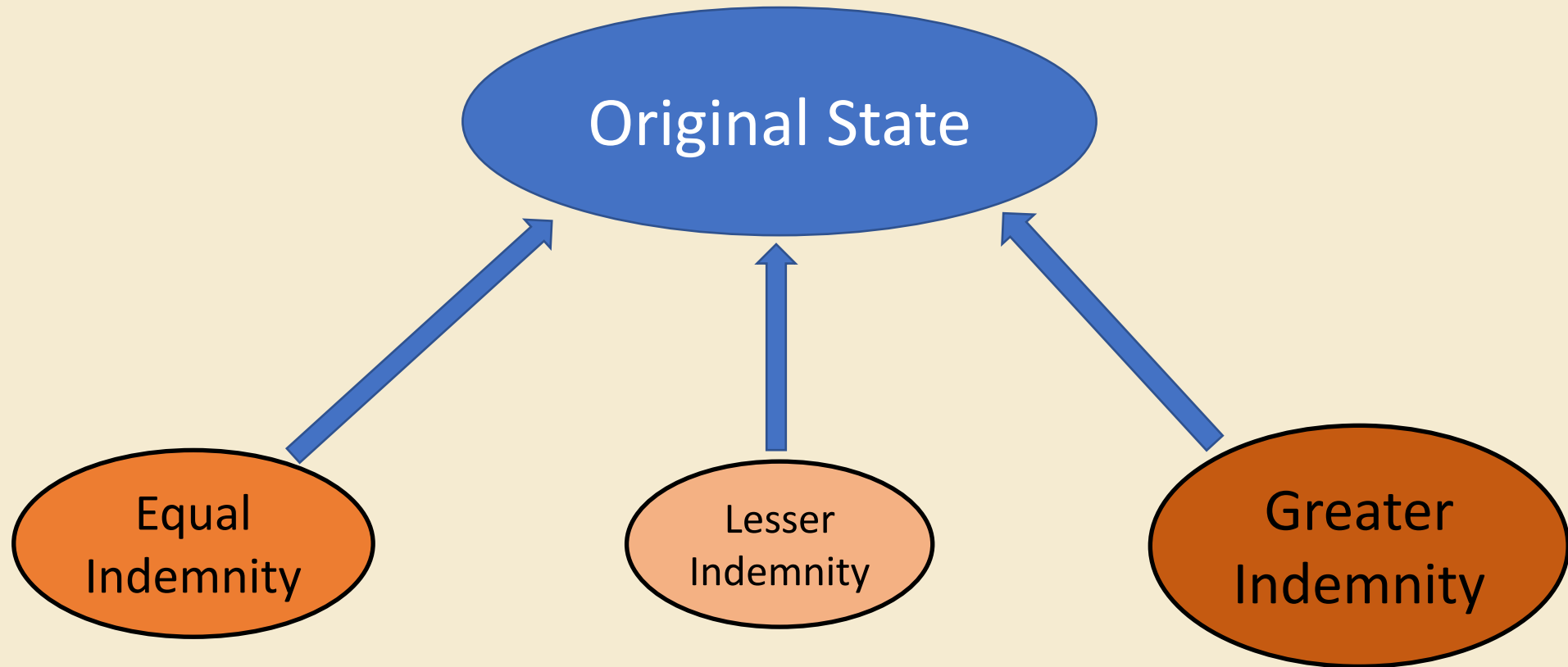

# Restoration through Indemnity

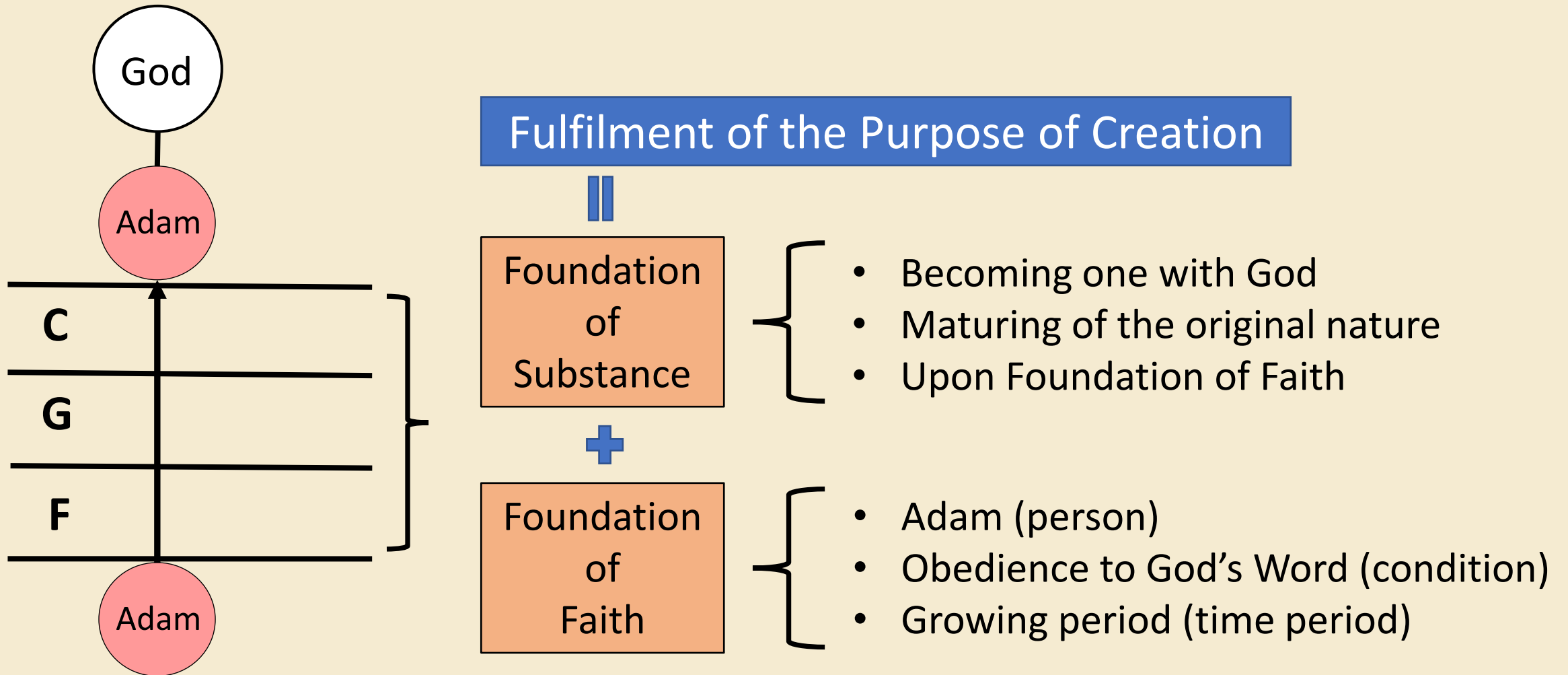
- When someone has lost his original position or state, he must make some condition to be restored to it.
- The making of such conditions of restitution is called *indemnity*.
- God's work to restore people to their true, unfallen state is called *the providence of restoration through indemnity*.
- *Restoration through indemnity*, then, is God's grace through which we can be restored to our original standing in relationship to God.

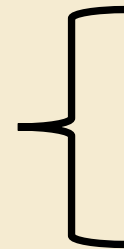

4. Multiplying evil

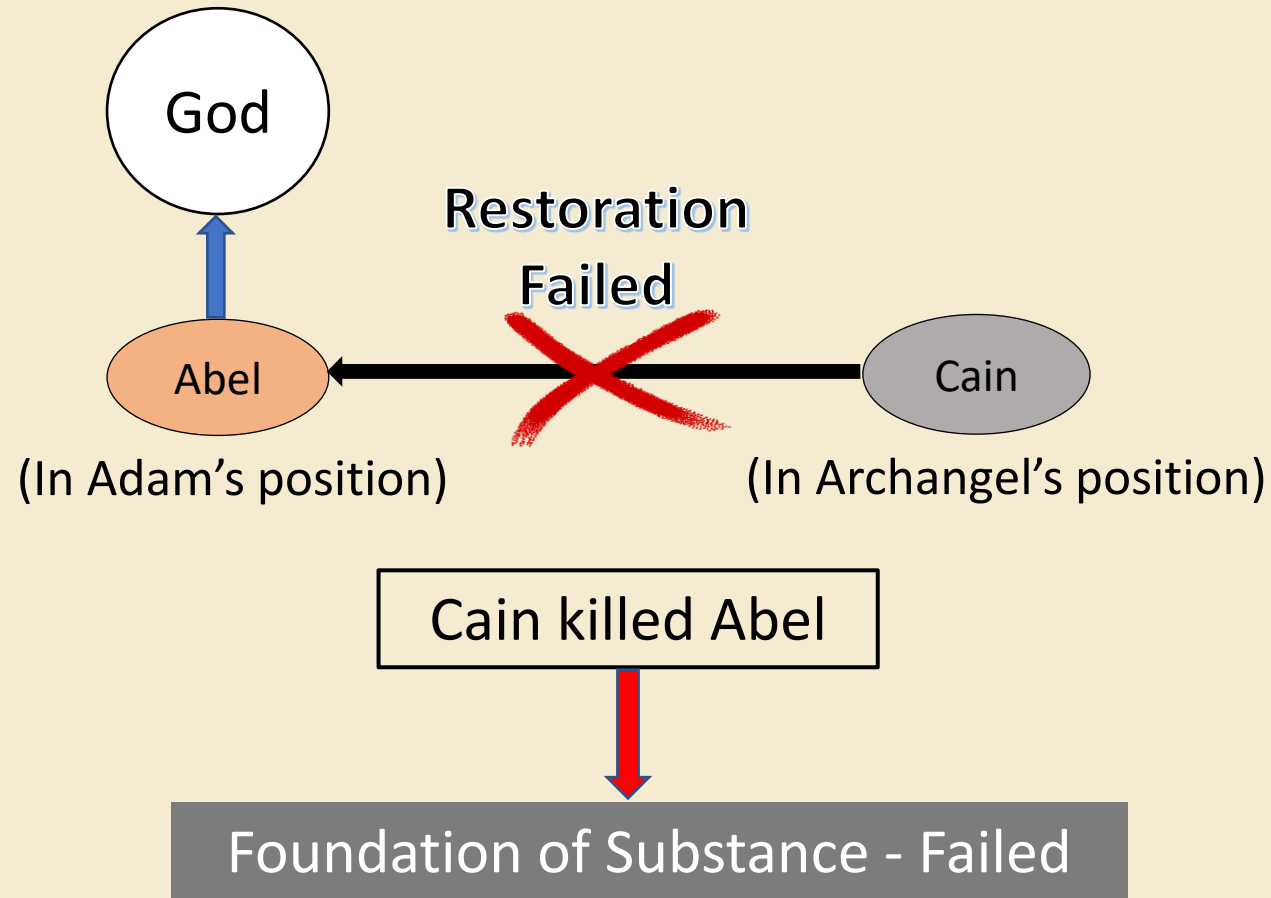

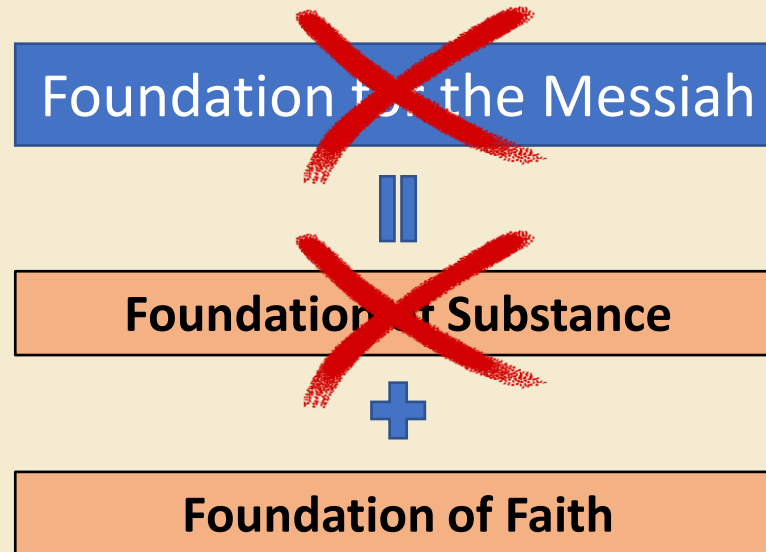
## Indemnity conditions

# Lessons Learned from Adam's Family

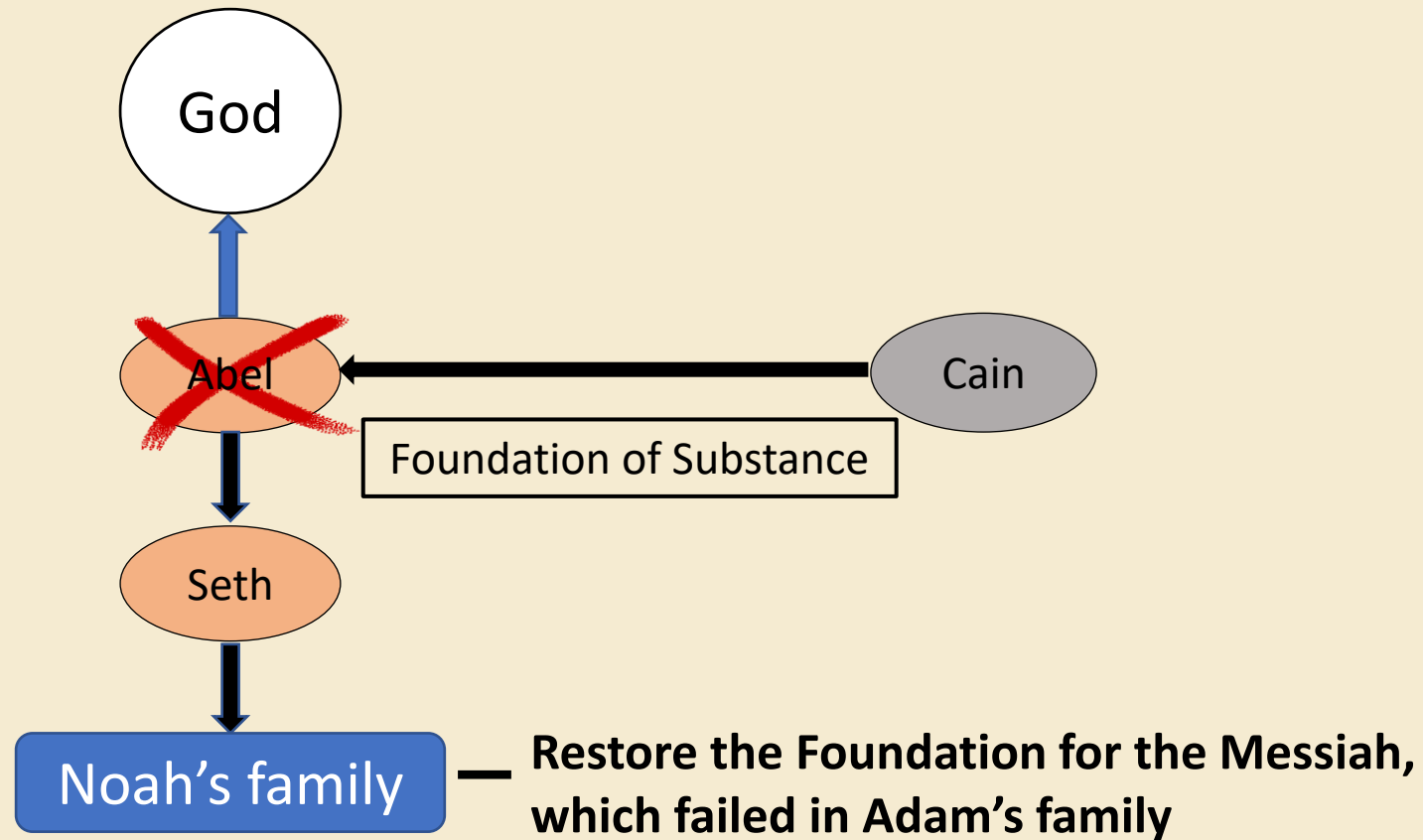
- 1 [ **Accomplishment of God's Will** ----- Conditional predestination

- 3 — **Fallen People** ----- Humility towards Abel-type person

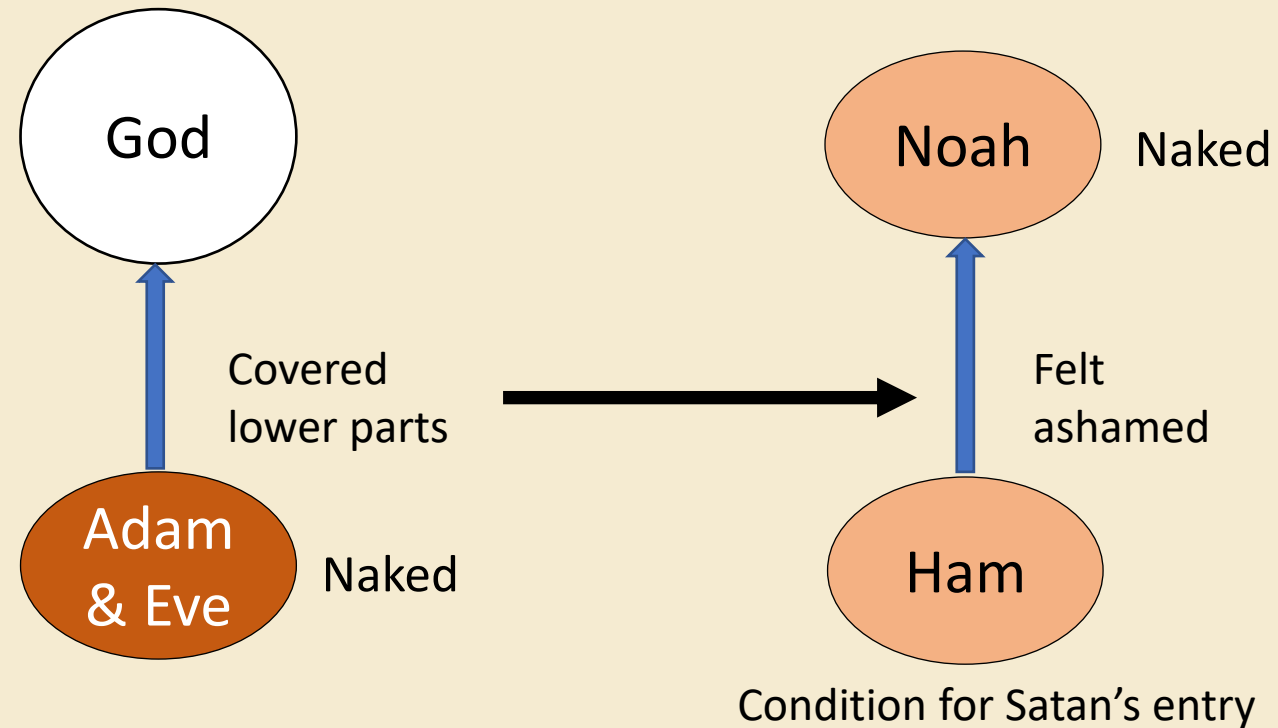

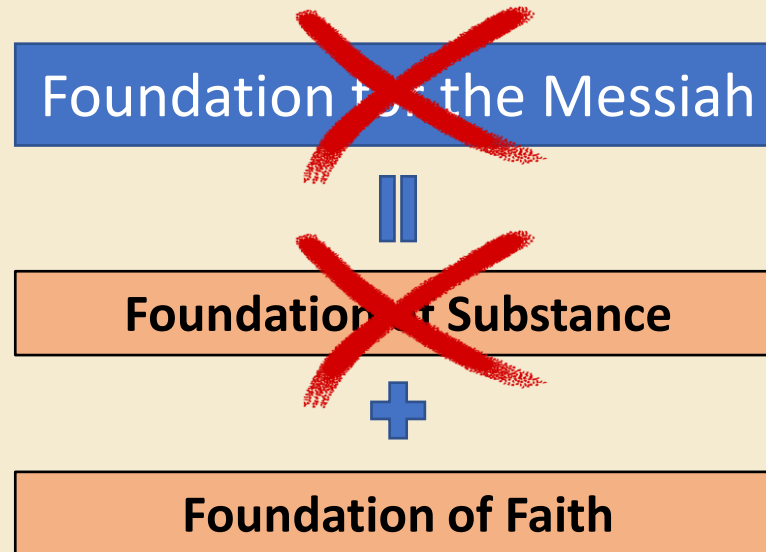

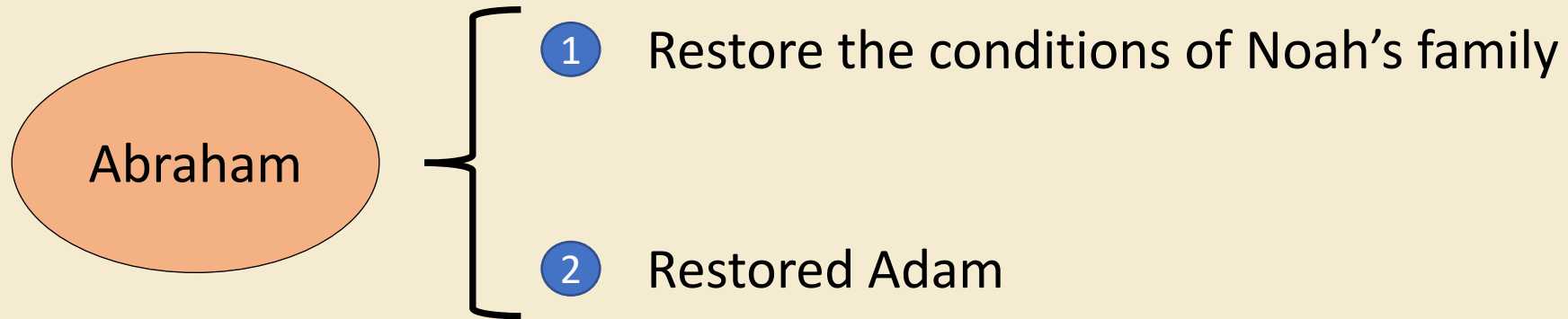

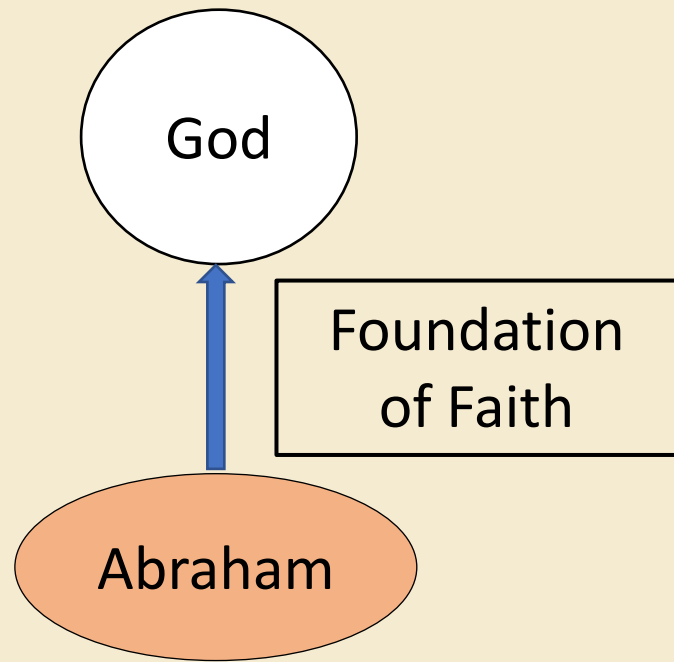

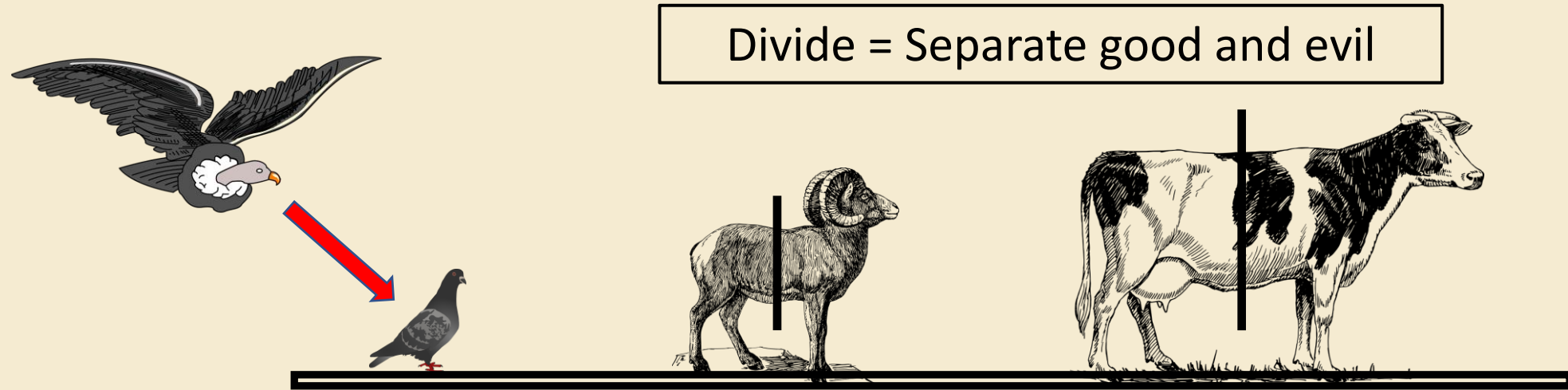
## Genesis 15:9

# How Abraham Made the Symbolic Offering

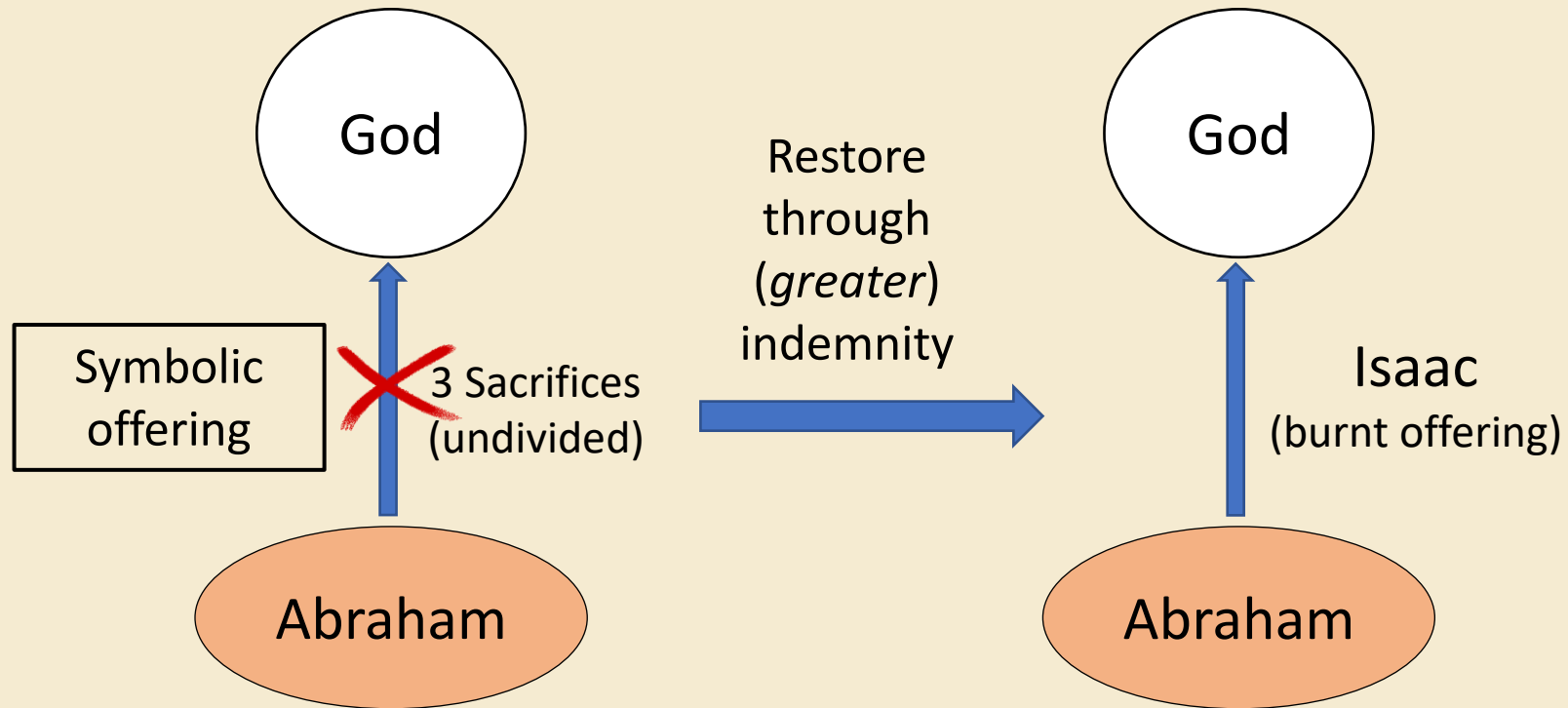


(Satan's possession)

- Providence: Prolonged through 3 generations

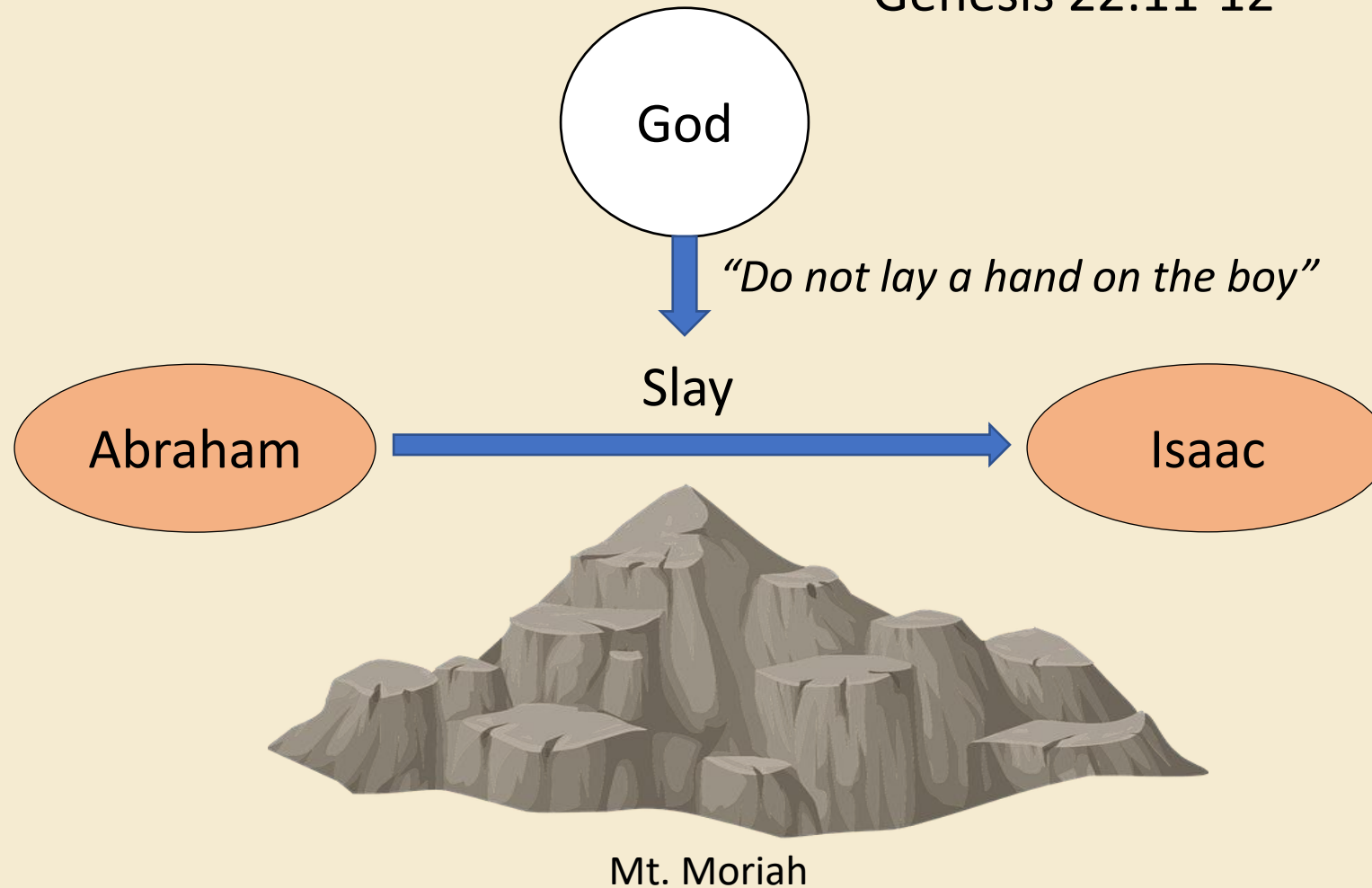

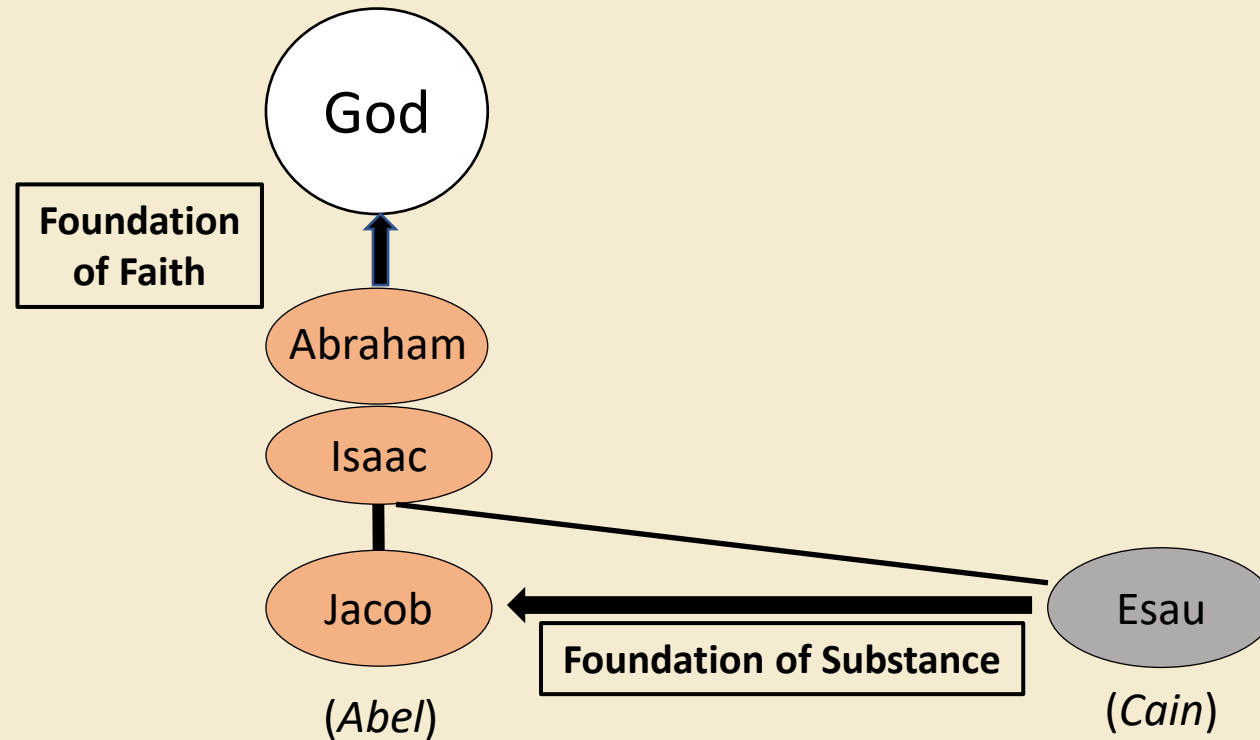

# Jacob's Restoration of Abel's Position

- ① Restored birthright on individual level (bread and lentils)
- ② Restored birthright with family and wealth (21 years in Haran)
- ③ Restored dominion over angelic world (wrestling with angels)



**Jacob: Restored Abel's position**

*Jacob looked up and there was Esau, coming with his four hundred men; so he divided the children among Leah, Rachel and the two female servants. He put the female servants and their children in front, Leah and her children next, and Rachel and Joseph in the rear. He himself went on ahead and bowed down to the ground seven times as he approached his brother.*

*But Esau ran to meet Jacob and embraced him; he threw his arms around his neck and kissed him. And they wept. Then Esau looked up and saw the women and children. "Who are these with you?" he asked.*

*Jacob answered, "They are the children God has graciously given your servant."*

*Then the female servants and their children approached and bowed down. Next, Leah and her children came and bowed down. Last of all came Joseph and Rachel, and they too bowed down.*

*Esau asked, "What's the meaning of all these flocks and herds I met?"*

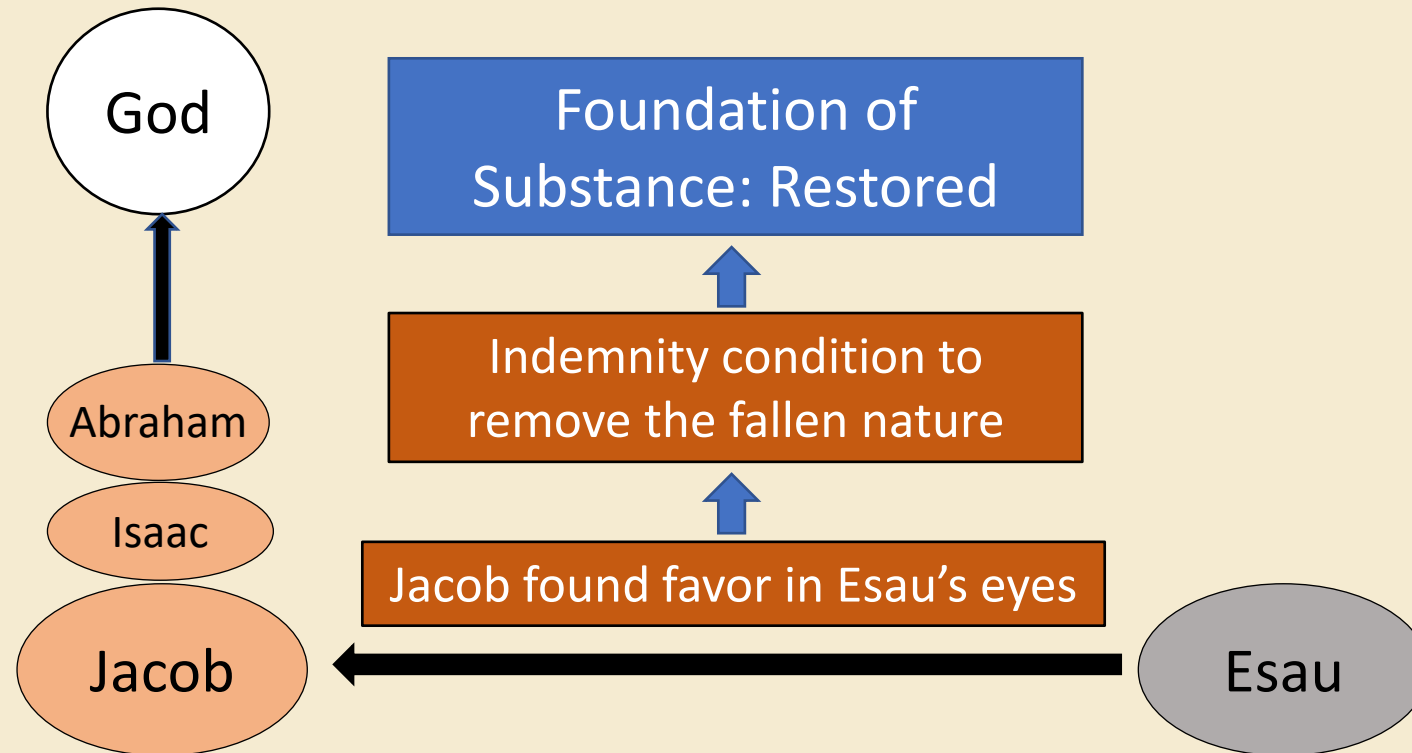
*"To find favor in your eyes, my lord," he said.*

*But Esau said, "I already have plenty, my brother. Keep what you have for yourself."*

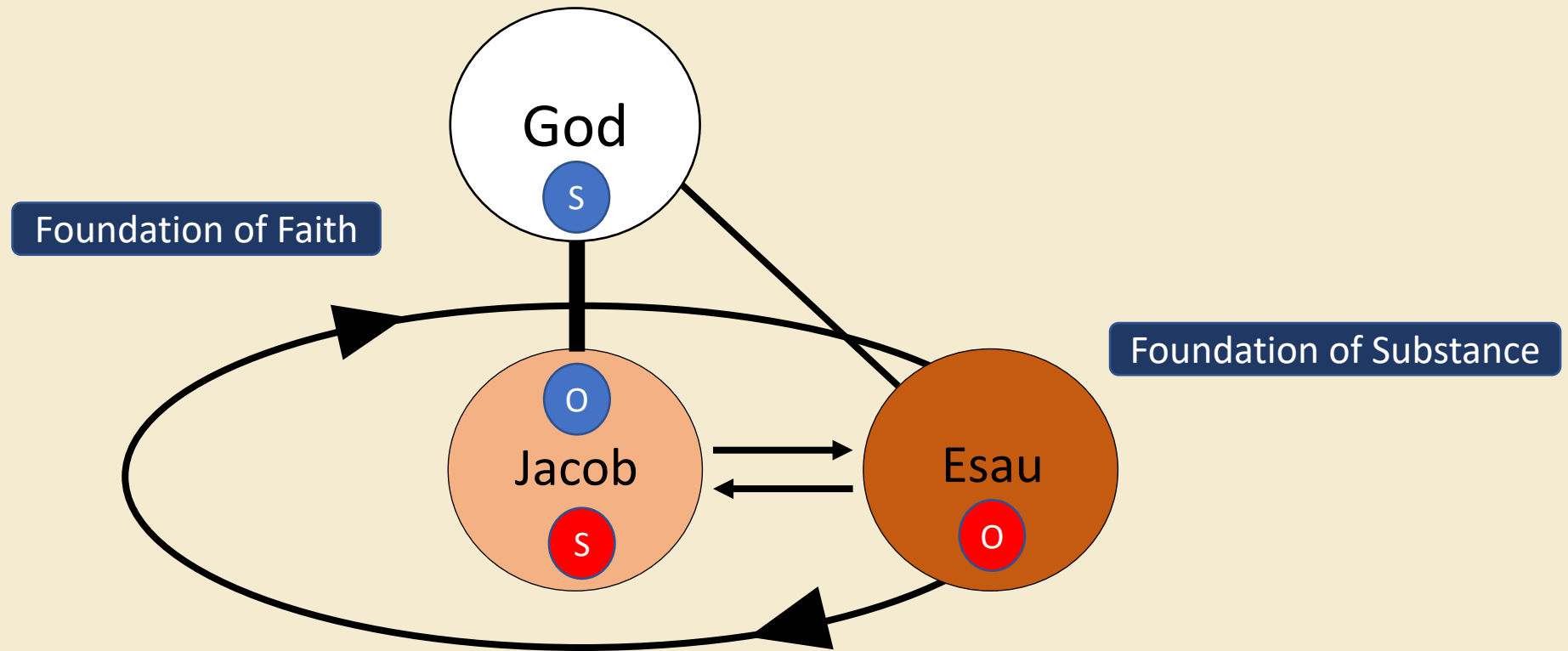

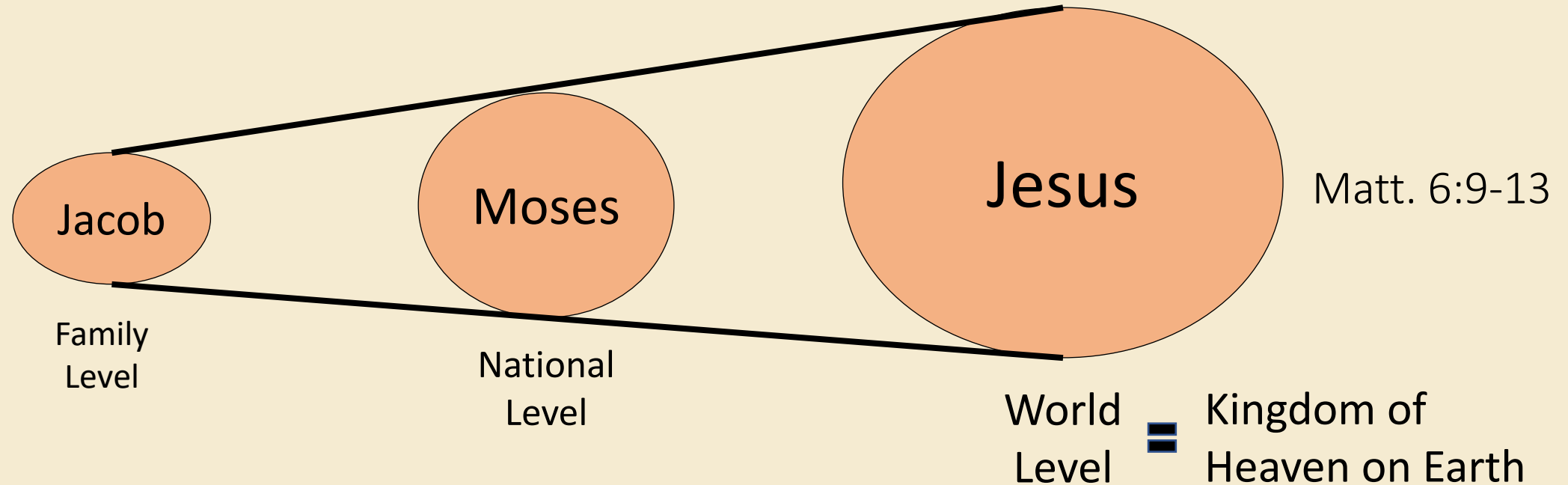
- Different individuals
