Beam Signing Event at Firestone Farms on September 10

(September 6, 2022)---(Salem, OH)---Members of the community are invited to participate in a special beam signing event to celebrate an important milestone in the construction of the SRMC Surgery & Outpatient Pavilion at Firestone Farms TownCenter in Columbiana. The state-of-the-art facility is scheduled for completion in 2023.

Beam Signing Event

On Saturday, September 10, from 4:00-7:00 p.m., the public is invited to sign a commemorative construction beam at the SRMC Surgery & Outpatient Pavilion construction site at Firestone Farms. The beam will then be placed into the building's steel framework later in the fall. This special beam signing event coincides with the SRMC Foundation's "Pink Out" breast cancer activities occurring at Firestone Farms throughout the day.

"We're excited to provide community members with the unique chance to become a formal part of the Hospital's long history of growth by signing a commemorative beam that will be used to construct the building's framework," said Anita Hackstedde, M.D., SRMC President/CEO. "Over the last couple of months, we have seen significant progress at the construction site as our building has developed. The new facility will feature an outpatient surgery and endoscopy center, advanced medical imaging, infusion therapy services and specialty physician offices; and represents SRMC's strong legacy of growth and commitment to the health of the patients we serve."

Project Features

According to Dr. Hackstedde, SRMC's Surgery & Outpatient Pavilion is part of SRMC's strategic plan to provide more convenient access to advanced outpatient procedures and treatments. A team of experienced healthcare design and construction firms is leading the project, with Wilmot Sanz serving as the Project Architect and Shook Construction engaged as the Construction Manager.

"This project is designed with the unique needs of our patients in mind and will transform the way we deliver healthcare by enhancing access to lower cost outpatient services that don't require a hospital stay," Dr. Hackstedde added. "At center stage in the new building will be an ambulatory surgery center, advanced medical imaging and infusion therapy services. Additionally, the facility will house separate suites for a plastic and reconstructive surgery program and specialty care physician offices."

"SRMC's launch of this innovative outpatient center is just one more example of how deeply we care about our communities and how we are always looking for ways to better serve their needs. The new

Firestone Farms building project is well positioned to meet our patients' needs of the future, as we advance our mission and enhance access to clinical excellence.
