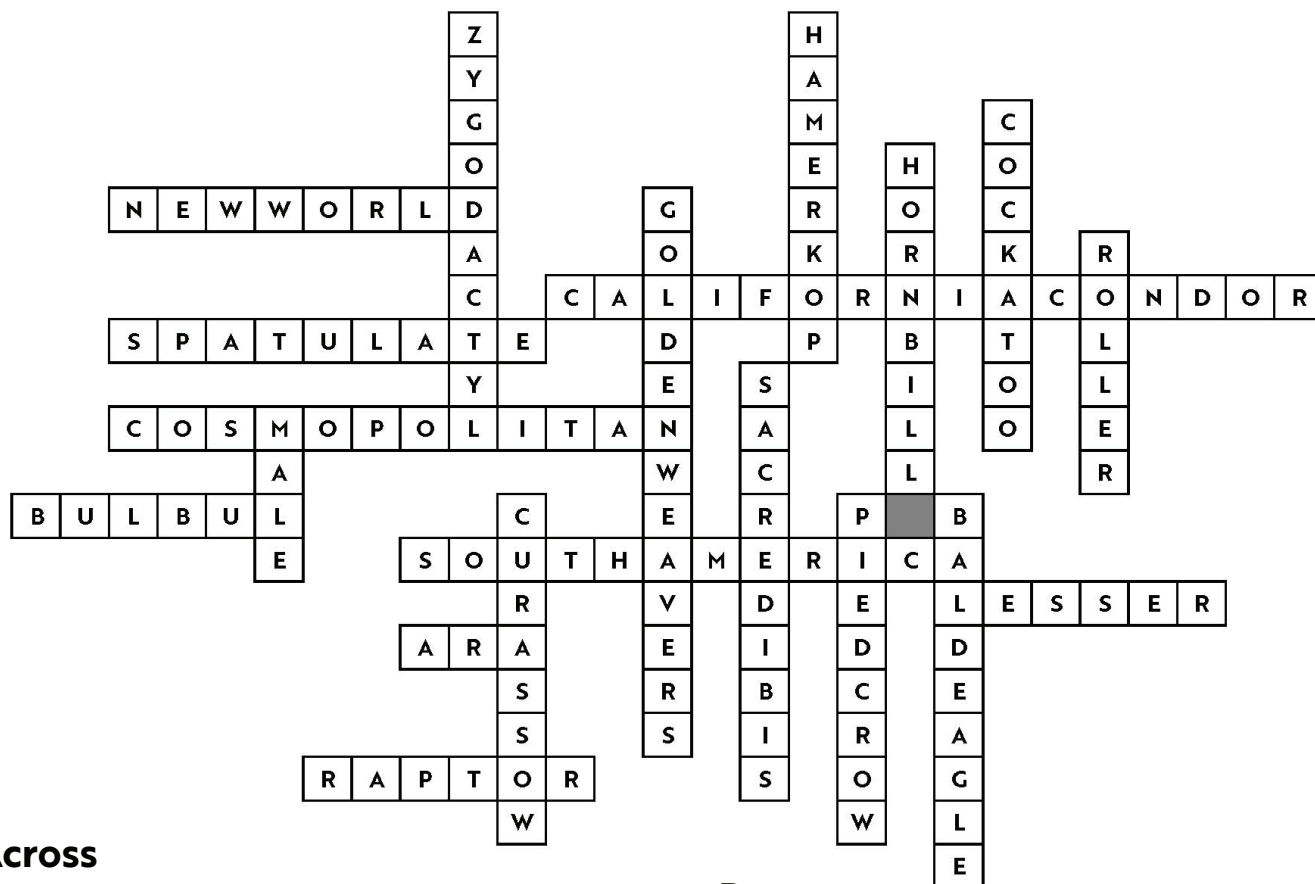




# OAKLAND ZOO BIRD CROSSWORD
