



- Oakland Zoo is home to wild animals. Speak softly and move slowly (no running).
- Report any disturbance of the animals or facilities to Zoo Staff.
- Feeding animals, pigeons, turkeys, squirrels, skunks and raccoons is prohibited.
- Keep safely behind barriers and only in designated public areas.
- Do not set children on railings or fences. No dangling items (or kids!) over habitat borders.
- Please, no sitting or standing on railings or fences.
